The Ordinance Was Approved On First Introduction With The Following Amendments:

Of the Supplemental Legislation - 4/27/2023, of 10.74.030 Definitions, On Page 3; Subsection F. adding paragraph 7. to read One (1) or more drivers is demonstrating or performing automotive stunts including but not limited to spinning doughnuts, vehicles swerving back and forth, burning rubber, spinning cars, racing or obstructing any public street, highway or in an Offstreet Parking Facility.

Page 5; of 10.74.060 Penalties and Violations, Section A. Paragraph 1. Violation a Misdemeanor., adding 'that may be charged by the District Attorney' to the last sentence.

Of Section B. Civil Penalties., adding paragraph 1. to read, The City may assess the following penalties for violations of this chapter: (a) one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the first violation; (b) two thousand five hundred (\$2,500.00) for the second violation; and (c) five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for the third violation and for each subsequent violation committed within a calendar year.

And, adding paragraph 2. to read, The City may recover damages caused by any violation of this section.
