**RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of *Jose Sierra v. City of Oakland, et al.*, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG20061307, for the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars and no Cents (\$400,000.00); and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to take steps that may be necessary to effectuate said settlement.
