RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Amending Resolution No. 89376 C.M.S., Which Awarded Grants to Community Service Providers, To Add Faith In Action East Bay, A California Nonprofit Corporation, As The Fiscal Sponsor For The Grantee "At Thy Word Ministries" For An Amount Not To Exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The proposed resolution will authorize the City Administrator to negotiate and execute a grant agreement between the City of Oakland and Faith in Action East Bay as the fiscal sponsor for the At Thy Word Ministries, which was awarded a grant for \$50,000 via Resolution No. 89376 C.M.S to distribute food to residents of East Oakland.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

On June 24, 2021, the Oakland City Council adopted Resolution No. 88717 C.M.S., which adopted the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2023 Biennial Budget Policy and appropriated funds for said budget's expenditure.

On June 30, 2022, the Oakland City Council adopted Resolution No. 89283 C.M.S., which adopted the City of Oakland FY22-23 Midcycle Policy Budget and established appropriations for grant awards.

On July 26, 2022, the Oakland City Council adopted <u>Resolution No. 89376 C.M.S.</u>, which awarded grant agreements to 35 community service providers to deliver services related to youth development, workforce development, homeless services, business safety, food distribution, and other important issues as part of City Council's Direct Community Grants Program.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

At Thy Word Ministries requires a fiscal sponsor to accept grant funds from the City of Oakland, but a fiscal sponsor was not named in Resolution No. 89376 C.M.S. The proposed resolution seeks to correct this omission (**Table 1**) and grant proper authority to the City Administrator to execute the grant agreement between the City of Oakland and Faith in Action East Bay, which has agreed to serve as a fiscal sponsor for At Thy Word Ministries. The amount of this grant agreement (\$50,000) will be unchanged.

<u>At Thy Word Ministries</u> will use this funding to provide food to individuals and families impacted by violence in East Oakland from January 1, 2024, to December 30, 2024. Specifically, At Thy Word Ministries will perform the following food-distribution activities:

- Provide 50 meals for quarterly Ceasefire call-in meetings.
- Provide Thanksgiving meals to 500 families living in neighborhoods impacted by gun violence.
- Provide Christmas meals to 500 families living in neighborhoods impacted by gun violence.
- Distribute 50 meals every Wednesday in neighborhoods impacted by gun violence.
- Provide meals to 50 individuals during one-on-one mediation and safety conversations with credible messengers.

This resolution addresses the citywide priority of holistic community safety by providing food to individuals and families who have been impacted by community violence.

FISCAL IMPACT

Adopting this proposed resolution will authorize the City Administrator to negotiate and execute a grant agreement with Faith in Action East Bay as the fiscal sponsor for At Thy Word Ministries. Funding for this grant agreement is available in the carryforward from FY22-23 Midcycle Budget to FY 23-24. Funding codes are provided in **Table 2**.
