RE: Resolution Initiating the FY 2011-12 Assessment Process for the City Of Oakland Wildfire Prevention Assessment District and Authorizing the City Administrator to Order a Preliminary Annual Report Pursuant to the Oakland Municipal Code

SUMMARY

In compliance with the Oakland Fire Suppression, Prevention and Preparedness District Ordinance of 2003 (Ordinance No. 12556 C.M.S.), a resolution has been prepared initiating the annual assessment process of the Wildfire Prevention Assessment District (WPAD) for the FY 2011-12 property tax roll and authorizing the City Administrator to order the District Engineer to prepare and file a Preliminary Annual Report for this district with the City Clerk.

FISCAL IMPACT

This report is for the purpose of initialing the annual assessment process for the WPAD. Per Resolution No. 81740 C.M.S., the contractual agreement with Francisco & Associates, Inc. can be extended for two years through December 31, 2012. The contract extension is currently being finalized by the Department of Contracting and Purchasing and includes the service and cost of preparing the Annual Report. No additional funding is requested.

BACKGROUND

The City of Oakland formed the Wildfire Prevention Assessment District in January 2004 to finance the costs and expenses related to fire suppression, prevention and preparedness services and programs in the Oakland hills. The legislation forming the WPAD provides for the creation of a citizen advisory board, which takes responsibility for preparing a budget for council approval and recommending program priorities. The Annual Report will contain the advisory board's program proposals and the associated budget for the assessment proposed to be levied in the upcoming fiscal year. The Annual Report also sets forth the proposed amounts of the assessment on each parcel. Further steps are described below:

- 1. Approve the Preliminary Amual Report and adopt a resolution of intention. The resolution of intention declares the City Council's intention to levy and collect assessments within the WPAD for the tiscal year. The WPAD Advisory **B**oard program and budget proposals are incorporated into the Annual Report. It also states whether the assessment is proposed to change from the previous year and sets a date, hour, and place for a public hearing.
- 2. Conduct the public hearing affording all interested parlies the opportunity to hear and be heard. The public hearing is scheduled to occur at 6:30 p.m. on June 7, 2011.
- 3. Adopt a resolution contirming the information in the Annual Report and the levy of the assessment within the WPAD for tiscal year 2011-12.

The City of Oakland collects the WPAD assessment through the County of Alameda property tax bill. Upon fultillment of the requirements for the WPAD, the City of Oakland must submit the assessments to the Alameda County Auditor for inclusion in the FY 2011-12 property tax roll by August 10, 2011.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The purpose of this report and resolution is to initiate the FY 2011-12 assessment process of the WPAD. The detailed assessment data for all affected properties are due to the Alameda County Auditor-Controller Agency by August 10, 2011, for inclusion in the FY 2011-12 property tax roll. The proposed resolution orders the preparation of a preliminary Annual Report, which will set forth the tindings and engineering analyses for the WPAD.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

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There are no direct economic, environmental, or social equity opportunities or impacts associated with the City Council action requested in this report.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There is no direct impact to people with disabilities or to seniors associated with the City Council action requested in this report.

RECOMMENDATION(S) AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the proposed resolution.

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ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff requests that Council authorize the City Administrator to order a preliminary WPAD Annual Report pursuant to the Oakland Municipal Code.



RESOLUTION INITIATING THE FY 2011-12 ASSESSMENT CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR THE CITY OF OAKLAND WILDFIRE PREVENTION ASSESSMENT DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ORDER A PRELIMINARY ANNUAL REPORT PURSUANT TO THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Preliminary Annual Report shall be filed with the City Clerk for submission to the City Council for further action.
