Debris Materials Receive by Waste Management of Alameda County (WMAC)		
Origin of Debris	% of Waste Stream	Description
Single Family Dwelling (SFD)	32%	This represents the trash that WMAC collects from single family residential account holders at properties with 1-4 units. The material is collected weekly using burgundy and dark grey carts.
Multi-Family Dwelling (MFD)	15%	This represents the trash that WMAC collects from multifamily residential account holders at properties with 5+ units. The material is collected weekly using burgundy or dark grey carts, or green or dark grey trash bins.
Residential Bulky	3%	All residents can schedule a curbside pickup of large items (such as an appliance, mattress, furniture, etc.). Single family residents can do this twice a year. Multifamily residents can do this once a year.
Business	26%	This represents the trash that WMAC collects from business account holders. Trash is collected using burgundy or dark grey trash carts or green or grey trash bins.
Hauled by the Public to Davis St. Transfer Station	13%	This represents trash that members of the public haul directly to WM's Davis Street Transfer Station.
Hauled by the City to Davis St. Transfer Station	8%	This represents trash that City crews haul directly to WM's Davis Street Transfer Station. This material is from removal of illegal dumping, park maintenance trash, homeless encampment debris, street litter containers serviced on the weekend, and other clean up tasks.
Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) Hauled by WMAC	1%	This represents construction and demolition debris placed in WMAC dumpsters at construction sites and collected by WMAC.
C&D Hauled by Public to Davis Street or Altamont	2%	This represents construction and demolition debris hauled by members of the public to either WM's Davis St. Transfer Station or the Altamont Landfill.
