#### Notes

1. Anticipated construction completion reflects a snapshot in time of current conditions. Many factors outside of OakDOT's control that may impact delivery timelines include the City's contracting and procurement process, contractor availability, and severe and inclement weather. For traffic studies, this column reflects the anticipated completion date of the and NOT the construction completion date.

2. Additional Rapid Response investigations are added on an ongoing basis. The Rapid Response Program is activated following fatal traffic collisions involving vulnerable populations, including but not limited to children, seniors, people with disabilities, pedestrians, and bicyclists. The Program involves an engineering assessment that is separate and informed by police investigation of the crash, focused on the prevention of future loss of life. Identified improvements are delivered through the Rapid Response Program (via a maintenance treatment or quick-build improvement) or through other existing programs, such as the paving program or capital improvements when there are existing plans for improvements as part of a larger project. In some cases, the engineering investigation may determine that the crash and resulting fatality was not preventable through engineering treatments, and no engineering action is identified for these cases.

Numerous Rapid Response investigations over the last year were related to fatalities on International Boulevard. Improvements developed from these investigations were folded into the International Boulevard Quick Build Project.

3. OakDOT plays a supportive role in the City's Sideshow Prevention Pilot program and relies on the City Administrator's Office and Oakland Police Department to identify and prioritize locations of the most dangerous and persistent sideshows in the City where enforcement efforts may benefit from engineering strategies. OPD then refers these locations to OakDOT for installation of hardened center lines. Please note OakDOT no longer installs Botts' Dots as part of the Sideshow Prevention Pilot based on their lack of demonstrated effectiveness and durability; slipping concerns from people bicycling and motorcycling; and their high maintenance burden.

4. School zone speed limit lowering also includes bringing existing school signage and markings up to current day standards. The specific upgrades will vary depending on site conditions at each school location and may include replacement of signage with high-visibility/fluorescent signage, relocation of signage that may be obscured, remarking faded crosswalks, remarking faded curbs, etc.

5. The Speed Bump program is a resident-led petition process. Because OakDOT receives applcations on an ongoing basis, the number of locations under review and/or approved for installations will change throughout the course of the year.

6. One additional FY 21-23 Council Earmark is not captured on this list (Sidewalk Cut-outs) because it will not be delivered through the Traffic Engineering Section.

7. In addition to the minor capital projects on this table, the Traffic Engineering Section manages investigation and any resulting implementation related to general traffic safety requests and traffic safety requests from school officials, as well as citywide speed limit management.
