Honorable President Larry Reid and Members of the City Council:

Subject: Ordinance to Amend the City of Oakland's Conflict of Interest Code (Ordinance number 11562 C.M.S, as amended, Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 3.16.)

Attached please find a proposed amendment to the City of Oakland's Conflict of Interest Code. The Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 87306.5, requires every local government agency to review its conflict of interest code and report to its code reviewing body whether it is necessary either to amend the code or to report that no amendment is necessary. The City Council is the code reviewing body for the City's Conflict of Interest Code.

The City Attorney has reviewed the City of Oakland's Conflict of Interest Code and determined that amendments are necessary. The code requires amending in the areas shown below.

- 1) Include new positions that must be designated.
- 2) Make changes to the positions assigned.
- 3) Revise the titles of existing positions.
- 4) Delete titles of positions that have been abolished.

The following departmental changes were made since the last amendment and have been included in this proposed code amendment:

1. The Design and Construction Division was moved from the Community and Economic Development Agency to the Public Works Agency on July 1, 2010.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF OAKLAND'S CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE (ORDINANCE NUMBER 11562 C.M.S ADOPTED MARCH 23, 1993, AS AMENDED, OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 3.16) ENACTING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR CITY OF OAKLAND EMPLOYEES, MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, AND CONSULTANT POSITIONS TO UPDATE THE DESIGNATION OF POSITIONS COVERED BY THE CODE

WHEREAS, pursuant to the State of California Political Reform Act, the City of Oakland enacted Ordinance Number 11562 C.M.S. on March 23, 1993, enacting a conflict of interest code for City of Oakland employees, members of boards and commissions, and consultant positions;

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act requires that every two (2) years in even numbered years, the code reviewing body review its conflict of interest code to determine whether it contains properly designated positions including employee positions, members of boards and commissions, and consultant positions; and

WHEREAS, the City Attomey recommends that City of Oakland Conflict of Interest Code, Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 3.16, be amended to include new positions which must be designated, make changes to the positions designated, revise titles of existing positions, departments, boards and commissions and delete titles of positions that have been abolished; and

WHEREAS, City of Oakland departments, boards, commissions and consultants have been notified that the Code has been reviewed; now therefore be it ordained:

Now Therefore the City Council of the City of Oakland does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Oakland Municipal Code (O.M.C.) Chapter 3.16.030 Appendix A is hereby amended to add, delete, or modify the designated positions as set forth below (additions are indicated by <u>underscoring</u> and deletions are indicated by strike-through-type; designated positions not cited or not shown in underscoring or strike-through type are not changed).
