A City Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator To Execute A Five Year Lease Extension With Two (2) Five Year Options To Renew The Existing Lease For City-Owned Communications Equipments Located At 1111 Broadway, With OCC Venture, LLC, A Delaware Limited Liability Company, For An Initial Annual Rent Of \$120,000.

SUMMARY

This supplemental staff report provides additional information regarding the potential, if approved by City Council, for the City as the Lessee to sublease portions of the premises at 1111 Broadway to offset costs.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for the extended lease (\$120,000/annually) is in the FY 2011-13 Adopted Budget and in the Department of Information Technology's Radio/Telecommunications Fund (4200). The FY 2011-13 Adopted Budget anticipated the lease would continue at \$160,000; a cost avoidance of \$40,000 per year. The extended lease is not anticipated to have a negative impact on the General Purpose Fund.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

To offset the cost of the new lease, a lease provision will allow the City to sublease space to other public and private organizations to install telecommunications antennas and dishes on the City's rooftop towers. The Department of Information Technology will pursue sublease opportunities with Alameda County, East Bay Regional Interoperability Communications System Authority, and other organizations.

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ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

The City Council is requested to adopt the revised Resolution authorizing the City Administrator to execute a five-year lease extension with two (2) five-year options to renew the existing lease for city-owned communications equipment located at 1111 Broadway, for an initial annual rent of(\$120,000.
