### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends adoption of a Resolution awarding a construction contract to Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., for the Installation of Stormwater Trash Control Units on High Street Near Tidewater Avenue and on Alameda Avenue Near Fruitvale Avenue (Project No. C424420) in the amount of Seven Hundred Forty Three Thousand and Two Hundred Dollars (\$743,200.00).

### OUTCOME

Approval of this Resolution will authorize the City Administrator to execute a construction contract with Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$743,200.00 for the installation of two underground storm water trash separators collecting trash from storm water prior to reaching the Oakland Estuary. The project is fully funded by grants and will help the City meet clean water regulations.

This project will help collect trash pollution from the storm water flowing in the Oakland Estuary and helps the City meet the requirements of the Regional Water Quality Control Board's National Pollution Discharge Elimination System, Municipal Regional Stormwater Discharge Permit (MRP).

### BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

### **Regulatory Requirements**

In October 2009, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) adopted a new MRP that requires all cities to reduce the amount of trash in their storm drain systems by 40% by 2014.

#### ANALYSIS

On March 23, 2012, the City Clerk received four bids for this project as follows: \$743,200.00, \$1,014,000.00, \$1,034,626.00, and \$1,704,000 shown in *Attachment A*. Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc. is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and therefore is recommended for the award. The Engineer's estimate for the work is \$690,000.00. The construction is scheduled to begin in July 2012 and expected to be completed in October or early November 2012. The project schedule is also shown in *Attachment A*.

Under the proposed contract with Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., the contractor's Local Business Enterprise / Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) participation of \$334,700.00 (74.34%) exceeds the City's minimum 35% LBE/SLBE for ARRA funded projects. The contractor shows \$7,000.00 (100%) for local trucking which exceeds the 20% Local Trucking requirement. The contractor is also required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents. The analysis of the bibs by the City's Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing in *Attachment* B shows that Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc. has met the City's requirements.

The project is fully funded by grants from the State Department of Water Resources Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF), The San Francisco Estuary Partnership Trash Capture Project, and the Bay Area Stormwater Management Agency Association.

#### PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

Businesses and residents in the area will be notified by the City's construction Resident Engineer about construction activities, schedule, and the key contact person in advance of any construction.

#### COORDINATION

Offices consulted in the preparation of this report are the Office of the City Attorney and the Budget Office.

With the above sources of grant funds, the project will be fully funded. The approval of this Resolution will authorize the City Administrator to award a construction contract to Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$743,200.00.

#### PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

The Contractor Performance Evaluation in *Attachment* C for Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., for a previously completed project shows satisfactory performance.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The contractor has been verified for Local Business Enterprise and Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) participation by the Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents, which will result in dollars being spent locally.

Environmental: Health and safety threats to wildlife and humans would be reduced with this project collecting trash from storm water.

Social Equity: The City's waterfront landscape would be cleaner and inviting to all Oakland residents with this project collecting trash from storm water.

#### <u>CEQA</u>

The project is declared Exempt by the City and the State Water Resources Control Board for having no significant effect on the environment. The City's Notice of Exemption has been filed and later certified by the State Water Resources Control Board.

On March 29, 2012, the City Administrator's Office, Contracts and Compliance Unit, reviewed four (4) bids in response to the above referenced project on the base bid only. On April 19, 2012, the PWA asked for a revised compliance analysis to include Bid Alternates I through 4. This is an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) – Stimulus Funds project. Below is the outcome of the compliance evaluation for the minimum 35% Local and Small Local Business Enterprise (II/SLBE) participation requirement, a preliminary review for compliance with the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO), and a brief overview of the lowest responsible bidder's compliance with the 50% Local Employment Program (LEP) and the 15% Oakland Apprenticeship Program on the bidder's most recently completed City of Oakland project.
