WHEREAS, East Bay Agency for Children strengthens the well-being of children, and school communities experiencing violence, trauma, grief, loss, and life-threatening illness in over 35 schools throughout the City of Oakland through the Circle of Care/PALS and Probation Mental Health programs; and

WHEREAS, East Bay Agency for Children enhances student achievement through quality after-school and parent-child school readiness activities at Hawthorne Family Resource Center in the Fruitvale District and Sequoia Healthy Start in the Diamond District; and

WHEREAS, East Bay Agency for Children trains 10,000 children and adults annually how to protect against child assault, abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, East Bay Agency for Children teaches at-risk students the skills they need to manage the emotional and behavioral challenges that disrupt their learning including students in the Therapeutic Nursery School, Lafayette Day Treatment, Sequoia Day Treatment and Oakland Day Treatment programs in the City of Oakland; and


WHEREAS, East Bay Agency for Children connects vulnerable families to available health, safety net, and social services to foster self-sufficiency; now, therefore, be it
