RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that City Council adopt 1) Resolution Authorizing the City Administrator to Award a Construction Contract to Proven Management, Inc. for the Seisruic Retrofit of Coliseum Way Bridge (Project No. C346810), in the Amount of Two Million Eight Hundred Eighty Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Seven Dollars (\$2,880,847) in Accord with the Project Plans and Specifications and the Contractor's Bid; 2) Resolution Authorizing the City Administrator to Accept and Appropriate up to Three Million Six Hundred One Thousand Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$3,601,059) of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposition 1B Funds for the Seismic Retrofit of Coliseum Way Bridge (Project No. C346810).

OUTCOME

Approval of these two resolutions will authorize the City Administrator to award a construction contract to Proven Management, Inc. in the amount of \$2,880,847 and accept and appropriate up to \$3,601,059 of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposhion 1B funds for the Seismic Retrofit of Coliseum Way Bridge over Damon Slough Project. The work is located in Council District 7 as shown in *Attachment A*. With the approval of the second resolution, funding for this contract will be available in:

Department of Transportation Fund (2116); Engineering Design: Streets & Structures Organization (92242); Street Construction Account (57411); Project C346810; \$2,880,847.

The project will strengthen this bridge and improve its structural resistance to future earthquakes.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

On June 28, 2011, the City completed the construction documents for the Seismic Retrofit of Coliseum Way Bridge Project (Project No. C346810) and requested authorization to proceed

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with the construction phase from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). On July 18, 2011, Caltrans approved the construction phase of the project and obligated a grant of federal and state Proposition 1B funds in the amount of \$3,239,282 to cover the cost of construction, contingencies, and construction management. Staff is in the process of securing the remaining funds of \$361,777 from Caltrans for a total grant of \$3,601,059.

On August 25, 2011, the City Clerk received six bids for this project in the amount of \$2,299,999, \$2,449,362.84, \$2,880,847, \$2,898,267, \$2,907,103, and \$3,853,087 as shown in **Attachment B**. The apparent low bidder, Reyes Construction, Inc., failed to meet the minimum 2.9% federal Race Conscious Undemtilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (RC UDBE) participation goal. Therefore, their bid was deemed non-responsive. West Bay Builders, Inc., the second lowest bidder, met the minimum RC UDBE participation goal and was the lowest responsible and responsive bidder for this project.

The contract with West Bay Builders, Inc. was awarded by City Council on November 15, 2011 (Resolution No. 83620 C.M.S.) and the contract was signed by the contractor on December 9, 2011. However, the contractor has informed the City that their sub-contractors cost has increased; and therefore, requested to be released from the contract. Staff consulted with the City Attorney's Office and determined that it is in the City's best interest to release West Bay Builders and award the contract to the second lowest responsible and responsive bidder. The granting agency, Caltrans, has concurred with this recommendation.

Proven Management, Inc., is now deemed the lowest responsible and responsive bidder and therefore is recommended for the award. The bid price for Proven Management, Inc. is \$2,880,847 and the Engineer's estimate for the work is \$2,729,948.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

Adoption of the two resolutions will allow staff to accept and appropriate the grant into the project accounts and award the construction contract to proceed with construction. The contract specifies \$2,400 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract is not completed within 175 working days. Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2013 and be completed by December 2013. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment B*.

Because this project is funded by federal funds, the federal Race Conscious Undemtilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (RC UDBE) Program must be used in lieu of the City's Local/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) Program in determining qualified bidders.

Under the proposed contract with Proven Management, Inc., the UDBE participation of \$277,500 (9.63%) exceeds the 2.90% UDBE requirement. The UDBE information has been verified by the Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing, and is shown in *Attachment C*. For information purposes, the LBE/SLBE participation is \$0.00 (0%) and the Tmcking participation is \$0.00 (0%). Staff has reviewed the submitted bid for this work and has determined that the bid is reasonable and reflects the current construction climate.

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PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

Businesses and residents in the area will be notified by the City about construction activities, schedule, and the key contact person in advance of any construction.

COORDINATION

The project has been coordinated with the following agencies:

- Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum Authority for right of entry permit and to minimize impacts to Coliseum events and traffic during construction.
- Oakland Police Department (OPD) for additional traffic control during events at the Coliseum.
- Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District for right of entry.
- Transportation Services Division of the Public Works Agency for lane reduction.
- United States Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE).
- San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC).
- California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG).
- California Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB).
- City of Oakland Planning and Zoning Division for a Creek Protection Permit.

Construction in the Damon Slough Creek and on the bridge will be limited to the period from June 15th to October 15th to comply with environmental requirements and to minimize impact to the Coliseum events.

COST SUMMARY/IMPLICATIONS

Approval of these two resolutions will authorize the City Administrator to execute a construction contract with Proven Management, Inc. in the amount of \$2,880,847.00 and to accept and appropriate \$3,601,059.00 of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposition IB funds.

4. FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of these two resolutions will authorize the City Administrator to award a construction contract to Proven Management, Inc. in the amount of \$2,880,847 and accept and appropriate \$3,601,059 of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposition IB funds for the Seismic Retrofit of Coliseum Way Bridge over Daruon Slough Project.

With the approval of the second resolution, the project will have a total grant amount of \$3,601,059. The federal portion of this grant is 88.53% and the state portion is 11.47%. The state portion will serve as a local match for the federal allocation of the grant and the reimbursement will be based on actual cost. In addition to construction cost, other cost for inspection, material testing, construction management, and design support during construction will be also eligible for grant funding.

The City is currently responsible for maintenance of this bridge. The maintenance responsibility will continue, but maintenance costs should be reduced after the rehabilitation under this contract.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

There is no past performance evaluation on file for Proven Management, Inc.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: This project will improve bridge seismic reliability, ensuring continued safe use of the structure and allowing traffic to continue to use the bridge following an earthquake, which is critical to rapid recovery. The rehabilitation of the bridge will also reduce maintenance costs.

Environmental: The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete product. Best Management Practices for the protection of storm water runoff during construction will be required. The project will comply with environmental requirements to protect the creek and habitats by restricting the duration of work occurring in and above the creek.

Social Equity: The seismic retrofit of this bridge will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety, thereby benefiting all Oakland residents and visitors to Coliseum events.

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CEQA

Because this project is funded by federal funds, the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements apply in lieu of CEQA. The project has been determined by Caltrans to have no significant effect on the human environment and, therefore, neither an environmental assessment nor an environmental impact statement was required. The NEPA document was approved by Caltrans on May 11, 2009 and revalidated by Caltrans on March 2, 2011.




