#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that City Council adopt 1) Resolution Authorizing the City Administrator to Award a Construction Contract to Flatiron West, Inc. for the Seismic Retrofit of Hegenberger Road Overhead (Project No. C347110), in the Amount of Four Million Five Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars (\$4,569,963) in Accord with the Project Plans and Specifications and the Contractor's Bid; 2) Resolution Authorizing the City Administrator to Accept and Appropriate up to Five Million Seven Hundred Twelve Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars (\$5,712,453) of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposition IB Funds for the Seismic Retrofit of Hegenberger Road Overhead (Project No. C347110).

#### **OUTCOME**

Approval of these two resolutions will authorize the City Administrator to award a construction contract to Flatiron West, Inc. in the amount of \$4,569,963 and accept and appropriate up to \$5,712,453.00 of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposition IB funds for the Seismic Retrofit of Hegenberger Road Overhead Project. The work is located in Council District 7 as shown in Attachtment A. With the approval of the second resolution, funding for this contract will be available in:

Department of Transportation Fund (2116); Engineering Design: Streets & Structures Organization (92242); Street Construction Account (57411); Project C347110; \$4,569,963.

The project will strengthen this bridge and improve its structural resistance to future earthquakes.

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#### BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

On March 30, 2012, the City completed the construction documents for the Seismic Retrofit of Hegenberger Road Overhead Project (Project No. C347110) and requested authorization to proceed with the construction phase from the California Department of Transportation (Caitrans). On April 16, 2012, Caitrans approved the construction phase of the project and obligated a grant of federal and state Proposition IB funds in the amount of \$9,820,942 to proceed with construction.

On May 24, 2012, the City Clerk received four bids for this project in the amount of \$4,569,963, \$5,984,595, \$6,529,990, and \$6,822,004.70 as shown in *Attachment* B. Flatiron West, Inc. is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and therefore is recommended for the award.

The Engineer's estimate for the work is \$7,856,754 and the low bid is \$4,569,963 (41.8% under this estimate). The Engineer's Estimate has been analyzed and deemed reasonable considering the industry practice. However, the difference between the Engineer's Estimate and the bids is a reflection of the current economic conditions for the construction industry. Staff has analyzed the bid items with the design consultant and has looked at bids from other agencies for similar projects. It is concluded that recent bids have been coming errafically. It should also be noted that a conservative Engineer's Estimate is best to be utilized for funding purposes to ensure that sufficient funds are obligated and available by the granting agency.

#### **ANALYSIS**

Adoption of the two resolutions will allow staff to accept and appropriate the grant into the project accounts and award the construction contract prior to the grant deadline of August 16, 2012. The contract specifies \$6,800 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract is not completed within 175 working days. Construction is scheduled to begin in March 2013 and be completed by October 2013. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment* B.

Because this project is funded by federal hinds, the federal Race Conscious Underutilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (RC UDBE) Program must be used in lieu of the City's Local/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) Program in determining qualified bidders.

Under the proposed contract with Flatiron West, Inc., the UDBE participation of \$377,848 (8.27%) exceeds the 3.87% UDBE requirement. The UDBE information has been verified by the Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing, and is shown in *Attachment* C. For information purposes, the LBE/SLBE participation is \$346,000 (7.57%) and the Trucking participation is \$960 (0.02%).

Staff has reviewed the submitted bid for this work and has determined that the bid is reasonable reflecting the current construction climate.

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### PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

Businesses and residents in the area will be notified by the City regarding construction activities, schedule, and the key contact person in advance of any construction.

#### **COORDINATION**

The project has been coordinated with the following agencies:

- Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) District for right of entry permit and for BART Oakland Airport Connector and BART Seismic Retrofit projects that will be concurrently under construction. Work above the BART aerial structure will begin in July 2013 to allow BART projects to be completed in this area.
- Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Company for right of entry permit.
- East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) for utility relocation.
- Transportation Services Division of the Public Works Agency for lane reduction.
- City of Oakland Planning and Zoning Division for a Creek Protection Permh.

#### **COST SUMMARY/IMPLICATIONS**

Approval of these two resolutions will authorize the City Administrator to execute a construction contract with Flatiron West, Inc. in the amount of \$4,569,963 and accept and appropriate \$5,712,453 of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposition IB funds.

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#### 4. FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of these resolutions will authorize the City Administrator to award a construction contract to Flatiron West, Inc. in the amount of \$4,569,963 and accept and appropriate \$5,712,453 of Federal Highway Administration and State Proposition IB funds for the Seismic Retrofit of Hegenberger Road Overhead Project.

The City successfully sought and obtained federal and state finds in the amount of \$9,820,942 for this project. The federal portion of this grant is 88.53% and the state portion is 11.47%. The state portion will serve as a local match for the federal allocation of the grant and the reimbursement will be based on actual cost. In addition to construction cost, staff cost for inspection, material testing, construction management, and design support during construction will be also eligible for grant funding. Caitrans requires that the contract be awarded by August 16, 2012, to remain eligible for reimbursement.

The City is currently responsible for maintenance of this bridge. The maintenance responsibility will continue, but maintenance costs should be reduced after the rehabilitation under this contract.

#### PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

There is no past performance evaluation on file for Flatiron West, Inc.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: This project will improve bridge seismic reliability, ensuring continued safe use of the structure and allowing traffic to continue to use the bridge following an earthquake, which is critical to rapid recovery. The rehabilitation of the bridge will also reduce maintenance costs.

Environmental: The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete product. Best Management Practices for the protection of storm water runoff during construction will be required. The project will comply with environmental requirements to protect the adjacent creek and habitats.

Social Equity: The seismic retrofit of this bridge will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety, thereby benefiting all Oakland residents.

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### **CEQA**

Because this project is funded by federal funds, the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements apply in lieu of CEQA. The project has been determined by Caitrans to have no significant effect on the human environment and, therefore, neither an environmental assessment nor an environmental impact statement was required. The NEPA document was approved by Caitrans on May 11, 2009 and revalidated by Caitrans on March 2, 2011.


