WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) grant allocates funds to address unique planning, equipment, training, and exercise needs of high-threat, high-density Urban Areas to assist in building enhanced and sustainable capacities to prevent against, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department's Office of Emergency Services proposes to receive supplemental Federal Fiscal Year 2011 Urban Areas Security Initiative grant (Federal Fiscal Year 2011 UASI grant) funding from San Mateo County for services provided in connection with the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center (NCRIC) Operations, which is a federal, state and local public safety effort that involves the intake, analysis, fusion, synthesis, and appropriate dissemination of criminal and homeland security intelligence in the greater San Francisco Bay Area and the northern coastal counties of California; and

WHEREAS, the supplemental Federal Fiscal Year 2011 UASI grant funding can be used to reimburse fire department salaries and benefits for personnel that are assigned to provide services for the NCRIC and the distribution of such supplemental funding is administered by San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, the supplemental UASI grant funds to be distributed by San Mateo County will be used to reimburse the Oakland Fire Department for one Engineer of Fire position or equivalent cost position for salary and benefits for services provided in connection with the Northem California Regional Intelligence Center (NCRIC) Operations from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to enter into an agreement with the San Mateo County under which the City of Oakland's Fire Department personnel will provide services in connection with the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center (NCRIC) Operations from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 and San Mateo County will distribute UASI grant funds to the City; and be it
