RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF AMY V. DUNNINGTO THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Board consists of seven members serving three-year staggered terms with no more than two terms served consecutively; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Jean Quan has appointed Amy V. Dunning to serve a three-year term on the Civil Service Board subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Amy V. Dunning to serve a three-year term on the Civil Service Board beginning May 5, 2012 and ending May 4, 2015, filling the seat previously held by Michael Siegel; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appointment will take effect upon the resignation of the appointee from her position as a member of the Public Ethics Commission.
