RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO AMEND THE CONTRACT WITH STRATEGIC POLICY PARTNERSHIP, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (250,000) TO HIRE A CONSULTANT TO PUT IN PLACE A MUCH NEEDED SHORTTERM CRIME FIGHTING STRATEGY AND A CITYWIDE REDUCTION AND COMMUNITY SAFETY PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City Administrator is authorized to amend the contract with Strategic Policy Partnerships, LLC in the amount of \$250,000 to hire a consultant to put in place a much needed short-term crime fighting strategy and a Citywide Reduction Strategy and community safety Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City will seek the assistance and expertise of a crime reduction expert, with a proven track record to develop and implement a Citywide Crime Reduction Strategy and Community Safety Plan; and

WHEREAS, the crime reduction strategy will incorporate shorter-term actions to begin to reduce crime and a long-term Citywide Crime Reduction Strategy and Community Safety Plan that integrates partnerships with external law enforcement agencies and City departments; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to amend this contract in order for the City to ensure that an effective and measurable crime reduction plan is put in place to combat the rise in violent crimes by the utilization of best practices in the law enforcement realm; therefore be it

**RESOLVED,** That the City Administrator is authorized to amend the contract with Strategic Policy Partnerships, LLC in the amount of \$250,000 to hire a consultant to put in place a much needed short-term crime fighting strategy and a Citywide Reduction Strategy and Community Safety Plan; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland and the Oakland Police Department firmly and unequivocally stand with our community against racial profiling and are deeply committed to initiatives that promote stronger community collaboration, respectful policing practices, and a better, safer Oakland for all Oakland residents; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That ensuring effective, Constitutional policing is a top priority and that the Oakland Police Department shall not institute policies that impede this goal; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the executed contract shall include specific deliverable and deadlines for producing the Short-term Crime Fighting Strategy and a Comprehensive Citywide Crime Reduction Strategy and Community Safety Plan; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to take all actions and carry out any financial actions necessary to fulfill the intent of this Resolution and accompanying Report, including completing all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend this contract for services except for any additional increase in the contract amount, without returning to the City Council; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee will provide regular updates to the City Council concerning changes or modifications to the contract with Strategic Policy Partnerships, LLC; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee shall ensure that copies of fully executed contracts and amendments are placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney shall review and approve, for form and legality, any and all contract amendments and modifications.
