RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Council approve the revised resolution (Attached) waiving formal advertising, competitive bidding, and the Request For Proposals/Qualifications ("RFP/RFQ") requirements of the Oakland Municipal Code ("OMC") and authorizing the City Administrator or her designee to negotiate and enter into two contracts: (1) a contract with ShoreTel Inc. or an authorized reseller for professional services, hardware and software to upgrade the ShoreTel telephone system and annual maintenance for an amount not to exceed \$275,000.00 annually or \$825,000.00 for a contract term of 3 years; and (2) a contract with Enterasys Networks or an authorized reseller for the upgrade of hardware, software, professional services and maintenance of the City Services Enterasys Network for an implementation cost not to exceed \$1,200,000.00 and an annual maintenance amount not to exceed \$150,000.00 per year for a term of 3 years, for a grand total contract amount of \$1,650,000.00.

Additionally, staff recommends that the Council approve a resolution authorizing The City Administrator or her designee to appropriate current revenues and fund balance in Internal Services Fund 4210 for the ongoing cost associated with the delivery of telephone, network and telecommunications services for a period of 3 years without returning to Council. These costs include upgrade of the telephone and network equipment, maintenance and support, telephone lines and installation services.

OUTCOME

Based on the information provided below, staff requests that Council adopt the resolution.

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REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

At the March 12, 2012 Finance and Management Committee staff was given direction to

- Clarify actions being taken in regards to procuring the professional services, hardware and software contracts
- Change the Enterasys maintenance contract term to 3 years
- Change the City Administrator's appropriation authority to 3 years to match the length of the contracts
- Amend the Resolution

As directed, please find the clarifications requested:

- Staff needs to purchase products and professional/technical services to upgrade and maintain the City's phone system/network, Shoretel and Enterasys Network for several more years.
- City has invested approximately \$3 million dollars in these systems to date and it would be as or more expensive to replace these systems. It is significantly more cost effective to upgrade these systems.
- The Department of Information Technology has determined that the only vendors able to provide the requested products and services needed are Shoretel, Enterasys and their authorized vendors/dealers.
- A combination of products and professional/technical services are needed for the upgrade and maintenance of these systems. Therefore, city needs to negotiate a contract for the products and services.
- The purchasing ordinance requires the city to advertise bids for products, with advertising in the city's official newspaper (Oakland Tribune) and award to the lowest, responsible, responsive bidder i.e., no negotiation is allowed. The purchasing ordinance further requires city to conduct an RFP/Q for professional/technical services, negotiate and award the contract on the basis of qualifications. However, the purchasing ordinance authorizes Council to waive advertising, bidding and RFP/Q requirements upon finding that it is in the city's best interests to do so.

• It would be most cost effective for the city to negotiate with Shoretel, Enterasys or their authorized dealers/vendors for the products and services needed because a complete replacement of the system is cost prohibitive and unnecessary. Therefore, staff is seeking a waiver of the City's advertising, bidding and RFP/Q requirements for these purchases.

Based on the above statements, staff is requesting that the City Council approve the following actions:

- Adopt the resolution changing the contract term from five to three years.
- Total cost for the Enterasys network is now \$1,650,000.
- Approve a request to waive the advertising and bidding requirements for the purchase of Shoretel and Enterasys Services, hardware, software and maintenance for the City's Shoretel System and /Enterasys Network.

- (1) WAIVING OAKLAND'S ADVERTISING, BIDDING AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS/QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SHORETEL AND ENTERASYS SERVICES, HARDWARE, SOFTWARE AND MAINTENANCE FOR THE CITY'S SHORETEL TELEPHONE SYSTEM AND ENTERASYS NETWORK, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SOLICIT PROPOSALS AND PRICE QUOTATIONS SOLELY FROM SHORETEL, ENTERASYS AND THEIR AUTHORIZED VENDORS FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT, SOFTWARE AND SERVICES NECESSARY TO UPGRADE AND MAINTAIN THE SHORETEL TELEPHONE SYSTEM AND THE ENTERASYS NETWORK FOR A TERM OF THREE YEARS; AND

WHEREAS, the ShoreTel Telephone System and Enterasys Networks were purchased and implemented in 2005 per Council Resolution No. 79066 C.M.S., and the City has expended approximately \$3,000,000.00 on these systems to date; and

WHEREAS, the Shoretel Inc Telephone System maintenance agreement has expired and the Enterasys Network maintenance agreement will expire in 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Enterasys Network equipment is reaching its end of useful life and jeopardizes the performance of the Shoretel Telephone System and other City applications that depend on its performance; and

WHEREAS, it would not be cost effective and is not necessary to replace these systems given the city's investment, therefore, it is recommended that the City execute new Shoretel Inc. and Enterasys Networks maintenance agreements for equipment upgrades and maintenance to avoid equipment failure and lack of vendor support that would negatively impact the performance of the City's ShoreTel telephone, Enterasys Network and applications which provide telephone and network services to all city agencies and departments; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Municipal Code (OMC) Section 2.04.050 requires advertising in the Oakland Tribune (the City's official newspaper), competitive bidding and award to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder when the City purchases products from a vendor in an amount exceeding \$50,000.00, and OMC Section 2.04.050 1.5 permits the Council to waive such advertising and competitive bidding upon a finding and determination that it is in the best interests of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, OMC Section 2.04.051.A requires the City to conduct a request for proposal/qualification process ("RFP/RFQ") for the purchase of professional, scientific or technical services unless such process is waived, under OMC Section 2.04.051 B, upon a finding by the City Council that it is in the best interests of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Information Technology (DIT) has determined that only ShoreTel Inc. and Enterasys Networks or their authorized vendors/dealers can provide the necessary equipment, products and services that the City requires; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to purchase a combination of products and professional/technical services to upgrade and maintain the Shoretel system and Enterasys Network and, therefore, requires waiver of the City's bidding and RFP/RFQ requirements to negotiate contracts for each system; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to limit the solicitation of proposals and price quotes for the ShoreTel telephone system and Enterasys Networks upgrades and maintenance to Shoretel, Inc. and Enterasys and their authorized vendors because costs to upgrade and maintain these systems for the next three years is far more cost effective than purchasing new systems at this time, and no other vendors can provide the necessary products and services; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of the City's advertising and the City of Oakland will solicit proposals and price quotations from Shoretel, Enterasys Networks and their authorized qualified vendors for the purchase of ShoreTel and Enterasys equipment, software, installation and maintenance and seeks authority to negotiate contracts without return to Council; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Information Technology (DIT) has determined that the cost over the next three (3) years for upgrade and maintenance of the Shoretel Telephone System would not exceed \$825,000.00 (to be paid \$275,000.00 annually), and the cost over the next three (3) years for upgrade and maintenance of the Enterasys Network would not exceed \$1,650,000.00 (which includes \$150,000.00 annually for maintenance); and

WHEREAS, existing funds have been identified to fund the cost of the proposed purchases; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the contracts shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by and person having permanent status in the competitive service; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Council, pursuant to OMC Section 2.04.50 1.5 and Section 2.04.051 B, respectively, hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the City to waive the City's advertising, bidding, and the RFP/RFQ requirements for the purchase of equipment, software, maintenance and other services to upgrade the ShoreTel Telephone System and Enterasys Network for the reasons stated above and in the City Administrator's report accompanying this resolution, and so waives the requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to solicit proposals and price quotations solely from Shoretel, Enterasys and their authorized vendors for the purchase of equipment, software and services necessary to upgrade and maintain the City's Shoretel Telephone System and the Enterasys Network for a term of three years; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for the purchase of equipment, software, maintenance and other services for the Shoretel Telephone System in an amount not-to-exceed \$825,000.00 over the contact term of 3 years without return to council; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for the purchase of equipment, software, maintenance and other services for the Enterasys Network in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,650,000.00 for a term of 3 years without return to council; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to appropriate current and fixture funds in internal services fund 4210 for the ongoing cost associated with the purchase of the above telephone, network and telecommunications equipment, software and maintenance services; and be it
