A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, 1) TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE CALIFORNIA STATE PRESCHOOL PROGRAM (CSPP) EXPANSION GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$937,485 FROM JULY 1, 2013 TO JUNE 30, 2014, AND 2) TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITY COUNCIL FOR THE **ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF** \$98,170 TO **FUND** PREKINDERGARTEN AND FAMILY LITERACY SERVICES IN ACCORD WITH SAID GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland desires to apply for, accept and appropriate a grant in an estimated amount of nine hundred and thirty seven thousand four hundred and eighty five dollars (\$937,485) from the California Department of Education to fund California State Preschool Program (CSPP) prekindergarten and family literacy services from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding will be used to provide a prekindergarten and family literacy program in eight (8) sites located in the attendance areas of Oakland Unified School District elementary schools with 2005 Academic Performance Index (API) deciles 1-3; and

WHEREAS, the program will provide child development, parenting education and family literacy services to a total of three hundred and four (304) eligible three and four-year-old children and their families; and

WHEREAS, the Unity Council, a Head Start delegate designated for Oakland, was selected and approved in 1988 by the Head Start Policy Council, City Council, and the Head Start California Regional Office to provide Head Start comprehensive child development services in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a grant agreement with the Unity Council in an estimated total of ninety eight thousand one hundred seventy dollars (\$98,170) to provide prekindergarten and family literacy services to thirty-two (32) eligible children and their families; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the performance of the grant services is professional, scientific or technical in nature and that this grant agreement will not result in the loss of salary or employment by anyone having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for, accept and appropriate a grant in an estimated amount of nine hundred thirty seven thousand four hundred eighty five dollars (\$937,485) from the California Department of Education for funding of California State Preschool Program prekindergarten and family literacy services from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to accept and appropriate any additional funding related to this grant that may become available; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the estimated sum of nine hundred thirty seven thousand four hundred and eighty five dollars (\$937,485), the City of Oakland's portion of the grant award, together with offsetting revenue, shall be appropriated to the California Department of Education Fund (2138), Head Start Classroom & Seasonal Organization (78231), and HS FY13-14 State PreK-Basic Project (G464850-52) upon execution of said grant agreement, and that should additional grant funds be received, the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to appropriate same for the purposes described above; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute a grant agreement with the Unity Council, pursuant to the terms of the grant award, in an estimated amount of ninety eight thousand one hundred seventy dollars (\$98,170) of the aforesaid California State Preschool Program Expansion Grant for prekindergarten and family literacy services for three and four-year-old children and their families; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator or her designee to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests, and related actions which may be necessary for the aforementioned grants in accordance with the grants' basic purposes; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the grant agreement authorized under this resolution shall be reviewed as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and copies will be filed with the City Clerk.
