ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A FISCAL YEAR 2013-14 INCREASE TO A SPECIAL TAX IMPOSED FOR VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, AND PURSUANT TO THE VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND PUBLIC SAFETY ACT OF 2004 (MEASURE Y)

**WHEREAS**, in 2004 the voters of Oakland approved Measure Y, a special tax to fund violence prevention and public safety services; and

**WHEREAS**, Measure Y imposes a special tax on all parcels in the City of Oakland, except where the parcels are otherwise exempt from taxation by Part 3 Section 4 of the Measure; and

WHEREAS, Measure Y provides that beginning in fiscal year 2004-2005 and each fiscal year thereafter, the Oakland City Council may increase the tax only upon a finding that the cost of living in the immediate San Francisco Bay Area, as shown by the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all items, has increased since the 2003-04 index year; and

**WHEREAS**, Measure Y provided that any tax rate adjustment imposed by the City Council pursuant to the ordinance shall not exceed five percent of the tax rate imposed during the immediately preceding fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing on this ordinance to increase the Measure Y special parcel tax was held on June 4, 2013 at 6:30 p.m. in City Hall, One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, Oakland, California; now, therefore,

### THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- The Oakland City Council hereby finds that the Consumer Price Index for all items in the San Francisco Bay Area was 233.39 for calendar year 2011 and 239.65 for calendar year 2012.
- The cost-of-living in the immediate San Francisco Bay Area as shown by the Consumer Price Index, has increased 2.7 percent from calendar year 2011 and calendar year 2012.
- 3. The Measure Y special tax rate upward adjustment shall be 2.7 percent, effective July 1, 2013, pursuant to the Measure Y requirement that the rate increase equal the annual CPI increase for the San Francisco Bay Area, and at no time may the increase exceed 5.0 percent of the tax rates imposed by the Ordinance during the immediately preceding fiscal year.
- 4. The following rate structure will be imposed on parcels within the City of Oakland effective July 1, 2013 for FY 2013-14:

# **NOTICE AND DIGEST**

This Ordinance authorizes an increase to a special tax imposed by the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 (Measure Y), which was submitted to the voters by Resolution No. 78734 C.M.S. and approved by the voters in November 2004. The Act allows rates to be adjusted for changes in the Consumer Price Index, in an amount not to exceed five percent (5%), as provided in Section 4 of the Resolution. The proposed changes are a total increase of 2.7 percent for FY 2013-14. Effective July 1, 2013, the Single Family Residential rate would increase from \$95.05 to \$97.62, the Multiple Unit Residential rate would increase from \$64.94 to \$66.68 and the Non-Residential Parcel rate would increase from \$48.68 to \$49.99.

On Tuesday, June 4, 2013, the City Council of Oakland, California will consider an ordinance authorizing an increase to the special parcel tax imposed for violence prevention and public safety services in accordance with the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 (Measure Y). The ordinance proposes an increase, effective July 1, 2013, of 2.7% consistent with the Consumer Price Index for the San Francisco Bay Area. The Public Hearing is set for Tuesday, June 4, 2013 at 6:30 p.m., to be held before the City Council in the Council Chambers located on the Third Floor of City Hall, One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, Oakland, California.
