RG12610883, CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 28254-A, IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00) (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT – MOTOR VEHICLE INJURY)

**WHEREAS,** Plaintiff Anika Hamilton alleges she was injured when an Oakland Police Department patrol car struck her in a pedestrian crosswalk at 7<sup>th</sup> Street at Clay Street on March 24, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, The City has determined to compromise and settle Plaintiff Anika Hamilton's claim against it for the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00); now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of <u>Anika Hamilton v. City of Oakland, et al.</u>, Alameda County Superior Court No. RG12610883, City Attorney's File No. 28254-A for a sum not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00) payable by the City of Oakland; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$10,000.00) be paid to Anika Hamilton, In Propria Persona.
