## A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING VOLUNTEERS FOR THEIR COMMUNITY SERVICE TO MAKE OAKLAND A SAFE, CLEAN CITY

WHEREAS, Oakland's District 5 top priorities include public safety, economic development, successful schools, responsive government and volunteer power; and

WHEREAS, Oakland residents in District 5 are committed to provide a clean, safe environment for the children and family; and

WHEREAS, Since January 2013, on a weekly basis every Saturday, 9am – 12pm volunteers have committed to clean up trash, abate graffiti, and remove illegal dumping, and beautification; and

WHEREAS, Volunteer efforts are especially important because it allows us as members of the community to connect with our neighbors and colleagues to work together to help maintain a clean, safe neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, The volunteer efforts in District 5 create a partnership with citizens and the City which promotes personal responsibility and demands government accountability; and

WHEREAS, We have had a over 600 volunteers, ranging from ages 4 to 80 years old, and have collected over 1,250 bags of trash, including tons of illegal dumping such as mattresses and couches; now therefore be it
