WHEREAS, AASK played a major role in drafting and championing state and federal policies to minimize delays in the adoption of children with special needs and to increase funding for foster families; and

WHEREAS, AASK was one of the fust in the United States to receive a Seal of Approval and be recognized as a Leader in Supporting and Serving LGBT Families by the Human Rights Campaign; and

WHEREAS, AASK is celebrating its 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary on Friday November 1<sup>st</sup> with a Gala at Scott's Seafood Restaurant at Jack London Square;

WHEREAS, AASK continues to be a pioneer in foster and adoption services and continues to expand programming to meet the needs of our youth and families; now, therefore be it
