## NOTICE AND DIGEST

**PUBLIC HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 213, EXTENDING BY ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY (180) DAYS EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NUMBER 13158 C.M.S. REQUIRING A MAJOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO ESTABLISH OR EXPAND A CREMATORIUM WITHIN THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON INTRODUCTION AND ADOPTION (EXTENDS THE 180 DAY EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ADOPTED MAY 7, 2013)**

With the extension of the Emergency Ordinance any newly proposed or expanded crematorium within the City of Oakland will require a Major Conditional Use permit authorization for a period of one-hundred and eighty (180) days from the date of adoption or until permanent regulations addressing crematories are adopted by the City Council, unless the crematorium has a vested right under State law. In the 180 days after adopting staff will work to further analyze issues related to crematories and bring forward proposed legislation for permanent regulations.
