## NOTICE AND DIGEST.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 213, EXTENDING BY ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY (180) DAYS EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NUMBER 13158 C.M.S. REQUIRING A MAJOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO ESTABLISH OR EXPAND A CREMATORIUM WITHIN THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON INTRODUCTION AND ADOPTION (EXTENDS THE 180 DAY EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ADOPTED MAY 7, 2013)

With the extension of the Emergency Ordinance any newly proposed or expanded crematorium within the City of Oakland will require a Major Conditional Use permit authorization for a period of one-hundred and eighty (180) days from the date of adoption or until permanent regulations addressing crematories are adopted by the City Council, unless the crematorium has a vested right under State law. In the 180 days after adopting staff will work to further analyze issues related to crematories and bring forward proposed legislation for permanent regulations.
