WHEREAS, California state poet laureate, Juan Felipe Herrera, a judge in this annual competition, calls Obasi "a master of the deep breath" who writes with "the humanity-voice of Gwendolyn Brooks, the long-jeweled line of Ginsberg and his own Obasi magic"; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Youth Poet Laureate Program is a program of the Oakland Public Library in collaboration with Youth Speaks and more than a dozen community partners; and

WHEREAS, Obasi Davis, as Youth Poet Laureate, will represent the City of Oakland as an ambassador for literacy, arts and youth expression, have his work published in a forthcoming anthology, and receive a \$5000 college scholarship; and

WHEREAS, Obasi shines a light on the struggles, triumphs and resilience of Oakland, setting an example for all youth to tell their own stories through poetry and the arts; now, be it therefore

RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland expresses profound gratitude and appreciation for Obasi Davis, 2013 Youth Poet Laureate for the City of Oakland.
