RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution accepting and confirming reports of the City Administrator on the costs incurred by the City of Oakland for delinquent transient occupancy taxes and confirming the recordation of liens with administrative and assessment charges as necessary – pursuant to Chapter 4.24 of the Oakland Municipal Code, and directing the notice of lien and assessment charges be turned over to the County Tax Collector for collection.

OUTCOME

The lien will be recorded against four (4) properties. The parcels' delinquency represents \$12,816.10 for past due Transient Occupancy Tax. Failure to place the lien to recover the delinquent taxes will result in a loss of \$13,016.10 in estimated revenues to the General Purpose Fund. The \$200 in additional revenue is derived from the \$50 administrative fee per lien for the four (4) properties.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Pursuant to Chapter 4.24 of the Oakland Municipal Code, hotel owners/operators were sent notices during a review and assessment process to address delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes determined to be owed to the City. An administrative hearing for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes was held on November 6, 2013 to hear protests and to resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by hotel owners/operators regarding the non-payment of Transient Occupancy Taxes. The owners/operators were given the opportunity to appeal their cases in this administrative process.

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Date: November 7, 2013

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Following the administrative hearing, the Tax Administrator filed with the City Administrator a written notice of those persons on whom the City will file liens for unpaid taxes, penalties, interest and other charges. If these amounts remain unpaid or unresolved after the public hearing by the City Council, the City Council shall authorize by resolution the recordation of liens on the subject properties for costs incurred for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes and added administrative and assessment charges. The delinquent charges and assessments shall constitute a special assessment against said property, and shall be collected at such time as is established by the County Assessor for inclusion in the next property tax assessment.

The public hearing is scheduled for December 10, 2013. A resolution is prepared confirming the placement of liens on four (4) properties and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges.

ANALYSIS

Hotel owners/operators owe delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes and administrative fees to the City for accounts not resolved at the November 6, 2013 administrative hearing as shown in the attached list. Hotel owners/operators collect the Transient Occupancy Tax from transients on behalf of the City, and it is their fiduciary responsibility to remit said taxes to the Tax Administrator by the due date as determined by their reported annual business tax gross receipts. If the City fails to place liens to recover the delinquent taxes, the General Purpose Fund may potentially lose estimated revenues totaling \$12,816.10 and administrative fees totaling \$200, creating a grand total of \$13,016.10 for this period.

PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

Administrative hearings for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes were held on November 6, 2013 to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by hotel owners/operators regarding the non-payment of Transient Occupancy Taxes.

COORDINATION

In coordination with the Office of the City Attorney, the agenda report, resolutions, and supporting items attached to this report have been reviewed and/or approved for form and legality.

COST SUMMARY/IMPLICATIONS

If the City fails to place liens to recover the delinquent taxes, the General Purpose Fund (1010) may potentially lose a total of \$13,016.10 for this period.

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SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic:</u> Collections of delinquent transient occupancy taxes have major economic implications for the City's sustainability. The revenue source is relied upon to fund essential City services.

<u>Environmental</u>: There are no environmental opportunities resulting from the recordation of liens.

<u>Social Equity</u>: Collections of delinquent transient occupancy taxes have significant social equity implications for the City's sustainability. The revenue source is relied upon to fund essential City services to all citizens and taxpayers.
