A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING PROVIDING CITY OF OAKLAND GRANT FUNDS IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000 PER YEAR TO ALAMEDA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES (BHCS) AGENCY FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2014 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015, WITH A TWO YEAR RENEWAL OPTION, IF FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, FOR PROVISION OF HOMELESS SERVICES AT SEVERAL PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING SITES

WHEREAS, the Affordable Care Act has made new resources available for provision of homeless services connected with permanent supportive housing; and

WHEREAS, these new funds, administered through county health care entities, require a local match and provide leveraging of 75% to 100% in additional Medicare reimbursable funding for homeless services; and

WHEREAS, homeless services for permanent supportive housing services at the Harrison Hotel are provided currently by Lifelong Medical Services though a City Permanent Access To Housing (PATH) contract in the amount of \$200,000 annually through June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, federal homeless allocations, made through renewal of the McKinney-Vento Act, are contingent upon release of the 2014 federal budget and the exact amount of federal allocations is not known at this time; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated amount available for the purpose of providing homeless services at permanent supportive housing sites is expected to be similar to the \$200,000 awarded to Lifelong Medical Care for provision of the services during the current budget cycle; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Alameda County Behavioral Health Care Services (BHCS) Agency governing transfer of grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 from the City to the County; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement Memorandum of Understanding providing City of Oakland grant funds in an estimated amount not to exceed \$200,000 to Alameda County BHCS Agency for the period of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015, with a two year renewal option if funds are available, for provision of homeless services at several permanent supportive housing sites; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests, and related actions which may be necessary in accordance with this resolution's basic purpose; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said agreements shall be reviewed as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and copies will be filed in the Office of the City Clerk.
