Re: Adjustments to the Proposed 2014-2015 Midcycle Budget

Dear City Council Colleagues,

We propose for your consideration the following adjustments to Mayor's and City Administrator's Proposed 2014-2015 Midcycle Policy Budget. Please note that combining the \$36,681,750MM of General Fund revenue set-aside to reach the 7.5% Council-mandated level along with the additional \$2,089,875 proposed here for a "Vital Services Stabilization Fund," the City will achieve a combined 8% reserve level.
