RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution to reject all bids, waive further competitive bidding and authorize the City Administrator, or his designee, to negotiate and execute a construction contract up to the amount of One Hundred and Sixty Three Thousand Dollars (\$163,000.00) with Rockridge Builders, sole bidder, or in the open market for the Golden Gate Branch Library Exterior Window Restoration Project (No. B00570) in accordance with the plans and specifications.

OUTCOME

Approval of this resolution will reject all bids, waive further competitive bidding and authorize the City Administrator or his designee, to negotiate and execute a construction contract up to the amount of One Hundred and Sixty Three Thousand Dollars (\$163,000.00) with Rockridge Builders, Sole Bidder, or in the open market with another qualified contractor for the Golden Gate Branch Library Exterior Window Improvement Project (No. B00570) in accordance with the Plans and Specifications.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The Golden Gate Branch of the Oakland Public Library (OPL) is located at 5606 San Pablo Avenue in Oakland. The Golden Gate Branch has a collection of approximately 35,000 items. Circulating materials are largely of popular interest with a strong emphasis on fiction and jazz music. The African American collection is one of the largest branch collections in the system. The branch is equipped with thirteen computers with Internet access and word processing available for public use.

The Golden Gate Branch Library was established in 1899 and moved into its current Carnegieendowed building in 1918. The building has been a designated historic city landmark since

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1980. It retains the majority of its original wood windows, many of which have dry rot and leak. If this condition is not addressed, the windows will continue to deteriorate, likely causing additional damage to the building.

As part of ongoing efforts to maintain its historic branches while also providing a suitable environment for the safeguarding of books, computers, and significant interior architecture, OPL sought and obtained funds for window restoration at the Golden Gate Branch.

The project was administratively presented for a Cultural Heritage Review and endorsed by the Landmarks Advisory Board in July, 2013.

ANALYSIS

The Project was advertised on May 1, 2014. On May 29, 2014, the City Clerk received 1 bid for the project as shown on *Attachment B:* Bid Results (May 29, 2014). Contract Compliance deemed Rockridge Builders, the Sole Bidder to be non-responsive as their L/SLBE certification recently expired (*see Attachment C:* Compliance Analysis, dated June 20, 2014).

There is insufficient funding available to award the base bid to Rockridge Builders, in the amount of \$172,483.94, and maintain a 10% construction contingency. A construction contingency is typical for capital improvement projects.

Therefore, it is recommended that City Council adopt a Resolution rejecting all bids, waiving further competitive bidding and authorizing the City Administrator, or his designee, to negotiate and execute a construction contract up to the amount of One Hundred and Sixty Three Thousand Dollars (\$163,000.00) with Rockridge Builders, sole bidder, or in the open market for the Golden Gate Branch Library Exterior Window Restoration Project (No. B00570) in accordance with the Plans and Specifications.

Staff will initiate negotiation with the one and only bidder and endeavor to value engineer and / or reduce scope to meet project budget. As a part of this negotiation, Rockridge Builders will be required to renew their S/LSBE certification. However, should the negotiation be unsuccessful, Staff is requesting authorization to proceed to contract in open market as provided per OMC Section 2.04.050.J.

Staff has analyzed the scope and costs, and is confident that a negotiation will be successful.

42% of the project funding is from a Fiscal Year 2013-15 Community Development Block Grant which will expire on July 1, 2015, thus it is in the best interest for the City to negotiate the contract, and waive further advertising and competitive bidding as provided per OMC 2.04.050.I.5.

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PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

Public outreach for the Golden Gate Branch Library Exterior Window Restoration Project has been conducted by OPL through branch newsletters and announcements; public feedback to the Library has been positive and supportive of the project. The Friends of the Golden Gate Branch Library have endorsed the project.

Approval of this resolution will authorize rejecting all bids, waiving further competitive bidding and authorizing the City Administrator, or his designee, to negotiate and execute a construction contract up to the amount of One Hundred and Sixty Three Thousand Dollars (\$163,000.00) with Rockridge Builders, or in the open market with another qualified contractor.

2. COST ELEMENTS OF AGREEMENT/CONTRACT: The project scope consists of construction for the Golden Gate Branch Library Exterior Window Restoration as identified by bid plans and specifications.

The total fund allows for a maximum contract amount of \$163,000 with a standard construction contingency of approximately 10%.

4. FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this resolution will authorize the City Administrator or designee to negotiate and execute a construction contract up to the amount of One Hundred and Sixty Three Thousand

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Dollars (\$163,000.00) with Rockridge Builders, or in the open market with another qualified contractor. Restorations of the windows will extend the useful life of the windows and preserve the historical character as well as minimize maintenance repairs.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

Rockridge Builders has completed several projects with the City, including The Melrose Branch Exterior Windows Restoration Project and the work is satisfactory.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: Through the construction of the project, City of Oakland businesses will generate economic and job opportunities for Oakland residents, provide business tax, sales tax, other revenues for the City by those who work on the project.

Environmental: The contractor is required to recycle and re-use construction materials to the extent practicable and comply with City standards.

Social Equity: The restoration will enhance the public's experience of the branch library.

CEQA

The project is exempt from environmental review as the work is limited to improvements to an existing facility.




A-Location Map

RESOLUTION TO REJECT ALL BIDS, WAIVE **FURTHER** ADVERTISING AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT UP TO THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$163,000.00) WITH ROCKRIDGE BUILDERS, SOLE BIDDER, OR IN THE OPEN MARKET FOR THE GOLDEN GATE BRANCH LIBRARY EXTERIOR WINDOW RESTORATION PROJECT (NO. B00570) IN AND ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS **SPECIFICATIONS**

WHEREAS, The Carnegie-endowed Golden Gate Branch of the Oakland Public Library, 5606 San Pablo Avenue in Oakland, retains most of its original windows, but they have dry rot and have begun to leak, and plans have been developed to restore the windows; and

WHEREAS, there are two fund sources available for the project: Municipal Capital Improvement fund 5500, org. 92270, account 57212, Project No. B00570, \$104,700.00 and Community Development Block Grant FY13-15 (due to expire on July 1, 2015), fund 2108, org. 92270, account 57212, Project No. C467210, \$75,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the project was advertised on May 1, 2014, and on May 29, 2014, the City Clerk received one (1) bid; and

WHEREAS, the one and only bid price exceeds engineer's estimate; and

WHEREAS, the construction budget is insufficient for bid price and construction contingency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to reject all bids, waive further competitive bidding, negotiate with Rockridge Builders, or in open market, and award a construction contract up to the amount of One Hundred and Sixty Three Thousand (\$163,000.00) in order to complete the construction in a timely manner to meet funding timeline; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines based on the representations set forth in the City Administrator's report accompanying this Resolution that the construction contract approved hereunder is temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work, that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy or better performance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That all bids are hereby rejected and the City hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City to waive further advertising and competitive bidding due to pending expiration of grant funds pursuant to Chapter 2.04, Article 1, Section 2.04.050.I (5) of the Oakland Municipal Code that; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator is authorized to negotiate, award and execute a construction contract for the Golden Gate Branch Library Exterior Windows Restoration Project (B00570) with Rockridge Builders, or in open market, for an amount up to One Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Dollars (\$163,000.00) in accordance with the project plans and specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Council hereby approves the plans and specifications prepared at the direction of the Assistant Director of the Oakland Public Works Department for this project; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator is authorized to execute any amendments or modifications of the contract within the limitations of the project specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the successful contractor shall provide faithful performance bond and a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for the amount of 100% of the contract price and due under the Unemployment Insurance Act prior to execution of the contract; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality prior to execution and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
