

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA RAPID TRANSIT DISTRICT V. CITY OF OAKLAND (FRANCIS LOVE), ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. RG11601786, CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 29181, FOR A SUM NOT TO EXCEED ELEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$11,500) (PUBLIC WORKS—CONTRACT DISPUTE)

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District alleges that it incurred damages as a result of a breach of contract; and

RESOLVED: That the City of Oakland is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District v. City of Oakland (Francis Love), Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG11601786, City Attorney's File No. 29181, for a sum not to exceed sixty-nine thousand seven hundred fifty dollars and no cents (\$11,500.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of eleven thousand five hundred dollars and no cents (\$11,500.00) be paid to San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District.
