INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER REBECCA KAPLAN			

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF \$20,000 FROM COUNCILMEMBER KAPLAN'S GRAFFITI ABATEMENT MURAL FUNDS TO ATTIITUDINAL HEALING CONNECTION FOR THE THIRD MURAL IN THEIR SUPER HEROES PROJECT ON THE FREEWAY UNDERPASS ON WEST STREET, BETWEEN 35TH ST. AND 36TH STREET

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2013, the City Council adopted a budget that set aside graffiti abatement funds for Murals and Green walls in the amount of \$50,000 for each councilmember to address graffiti within their districts;

WHEREAS, Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan wishes to grant a portion of her Graffiti abatement funds to Attitudinal Healing Connection for the development and implementation of their Super Heroes project on the freeway underpass on West Street, between 35th and 36th Street; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with City requirements, Attitudinal Healing Connection will provide documentation for the use of the Councilmember's Graffiti abatement funds; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the City Council authorizes the use of \$20,000.00 from Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan's Graffiti abatement funds for a grant to Attitudinal Healing Connection for the development and implementation of the third mural in their super heroes project; and, be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement with Attitudinal Healing Connection for the above purpose, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
