RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS AQUATIC CENTER GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$45,000) FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2013/2014 – 2014/2015 GRANT CYCLE, AND IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$95,000) FOR THE FULL FISCAL YEAR 2015/2016 – 2016/2017 GRANT CYCLE FOR FUNDING FOR OAKLAND PARKS & RECREATION BOATING PROGRAM EQUIPMENT, SCHOLARSHIPS, STAFF TRAINING, AND EVENT SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways provides grants to public agencies that offer on-the-water training programs in order to enhance basic boating safety education; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding may be used to purchase vessels and associated boating equipment, provide scholarships for low-income boating participants, provide staff boating safety training, and provide a public boating safety event; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding will allow Oakland Parks & Recreation (OPR) to 1) purchase boating equipment related to youth and adult recreational boating programming used on Lake Merritt and the Oakland Estuary, 2) provide scholarships for fifth grade students from Title 1 schools in Oakland, youth from Oakland Recreation Centers, and low-income Oakland youth to participate in Parks & Recreation boating programs, 3) fund boating safety training for program staff, and 4) offer a public boating safety event; and

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways Aquatic Center Grants are awarded in two year cycles; and

WHEREAS, grant funds for the first phase of the FY 2013/2014 – 2014/2015 grant cycle totaling \$41,970 were accepted and appropriated in FY2013-14 by the City Administrator pursuant to the authority designated in Resolution No. 79714 C.M.S.; and

WHEREAS, the additional \$45,000 authorized by this resolution allows for FY2013/2014 – 2014/2015 grant cycle funding in an amount not to exceed \$90,000; and

WHEREAS, staff also wishes to accept and appropriate funds not to exceed \$95,000 for the FY2015/2016 – 2016/2017 grant cycle; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to apply for, accept and appropriate grant funds from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways Aquatic Center Grant program in an amount not to exceed forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000) for the remainder of the FY 2013/2014 – 2014/2015 grant cycle; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to apply for, accept and appropriate grant funds from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation Division of Boating and Waterways Aquatic Center Grant Program in an amount not to exceed ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000) for the FY 2015/2016 – 2016/2017 grant cycle; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said grant funds will be used for OPR Boating Program equipment, scholarships, staff training, and event support; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the funds shall be placed in the Oakland Parks & Recreation Fund (2996); Organization (502350); with a Project Account to be determined and that there is no matching funds requirement associated with this grant.
