Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled claim for the sum of Ninety Five Thousand Dollars and no Cents (\$95,000.00), payable to Paul L. Rein in Trust for John Dalton.

This action arises out of the above-referenced action, in which Plaintiff John Dalton, a disabled individual, alleges he encountered legally non-compliant parking and paths of travel in Lakeside Park on September 2 and 22, 2012.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 (moved by Councilmember Larry Reid and seconded by Councilmember Noel Gallo – 8 Ayes).

WHEREAS, Plaintiff John Dalton alleges he was denied legally compliant disabled parking and access at Lakeside Park on September 2, 2012 and September 22, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff John Dalton filed the above-referenced action to recover monetary damages for denial of legally compliant disabled access to him; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to compromise and settle Plaintiff John Dalton's claims against it for monetary damages, attorneys' fees and costs for the sum of Ninety-five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$95,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to perform injunctive relief pursuant to agreement of the parties to improve disabled access at Lakeside Park; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of <u>John Dalton. v. City of Oakland</u>, United States District Court, Northern District of California Case No. C13-0497 EDL for a sum not to exceed Ninety-five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$95,000.00) payable by the City of Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Ninety-five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$95,000.00) be paid to Paul Rein in Trust for John Dalton.
