Pursuant to Section 401 of the City Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled action. Due to the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances settlement is recommended in the sum of Eighteen Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and No Cents (\$18,625.00) payable to Plaintiff Andre Traylor and his attorney Thomas H. LemMon.

This action arises from an incident on November 6, 2012, wherein Mr. Traylor was involved in a motor vehicle accident when the vehicle he was driving was rearended by a police patrol car driven by Officer Stephen Choi on Broadway in Oakland. Mr. Traylor sustained injuries in that incident that required medical treatment.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, October 21, 2014 (moved by Councilmember Gibson McElhaney and seconded by Councilmember Kaplan – 6 Ayes, 2 Absent – Councilmembers Reid and Schaaf).
