RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$140,220.00) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY (OTS), FOR THE 2014-2015 SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP) TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT (OPD)

WHEREAS, grant funds totaling \$140,220.00 have been awarded by the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety (OTS), for the Police Department's continued participation in the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP); and

WHEREAS, the STEP is designed to reduce the number of people injured or killed in crashes involving alcohol, speed, red light running, and other primary collision factors through the combined efforts of the OTS and local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the STEP project dates are from October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Central Service Overhead (CSO) costs (12.03%) are not permitted by the grantor, therefore the General Purpose Fund will contribute \$13,368.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 84712 C.M.S., dated November 19, 2013, Resolution No. 83555 C.M.S., dated September 20, 2011, Resolution No. 81223 C.M.S., dated April 15, 2008, Resolution No. 80578 C.M.S., dated May 15, 2007, Resolution No. 80130 C.M.S., dated September 19, 2006; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator, or designee, to accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$140,220.00 from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the grant funds shall be maintained in the State of California Grant Fund (2159), Traffic Enforcement Division Org. (107510); Traffic Enforcement Program (PS14), in a Project to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the General Fund contributes \$13,368 in cover CSO costs (12.03%); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award.
