RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution accepting and confirming reports of the City Administrator on the costs incurred by the City of Oakland for delinquent real property transfer taxes and confirming the recordation of liens with administrative and assessment charges as necessary – pursuant to Chapter 4.20 of the Oakland Municipal Code, and directing the notice of lien and assessment charges be turned over to the County Tax Collector for collection.

OUTCOME

Administrative hearings for delinquent real property transfer taxes were held on September 8, 2014, October 6, 2014 and November 3, 2014 to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by property owners regarding the non-payment of real property transfer taxes. A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on eleven (11) properties and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges.

Staff requests that the City Council approve the placement of liens on all unpaid real property transfer tax accounts and authorize the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges should they remain unpaid prior to the transfer of said assessment to the County Assessor for inclusion on the next property tax assessment.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Pursuant to Chapter 4.20 of the Oakland Municipal Code, administrative hearings for delinquent real property transfer taxes were held on September 8, 2014, October 6, 2014 and November 3, 2014 to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by property owners regarding the non-payment of real property transfer taxes.

Following the administrative hearings, the Finance Director filed with the City Administrator a written notice of those persons on whom the City will file liens for unpaid taxes, penalties, interest and other charges. If these amounts remain unpaid or unresolved after a public hearing by the City Council, the City Council shall authorize by resolution the recordation of liens on the subject properties for costs incurred for delinquent real property transfer taxes, added administrative, and assessment charges. The delinquent charges and assessments shall constitute a special assessment against said property, and shall be collected at such time as is established by the County Assessor for inclusion in the next property tax assessment.

The Public Hearing is scheduled for December 9, 2014. A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on eleven (11) properties and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges.

ANALYSIS

Property owners owe the City delinquent real property transfer taxes and administrative fees for the accounts not resolved at the September 8, 20f4, October 6, 2014 and November 3, 2014 administrative hearings as shown in the *attached list*. If the City fails to place a lien to recover the delinquent taxes, the General Purpose Fund may potentially lose estimated revenue totaling \$57,243 and administrative fees totaling \$550, creating a grand total of \$57,793 for this period.

PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

Administrative hearings for delinquent real property transfer taxes were held September 8, 2014, October 6, 2014 and November 3, 2014 to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by property owners regarding the non-payment of real property transfer taxes.

COORDINATION

In coordination with the Office of the City Attorney and the Budget Office, the agenda report, resolutions, and supporting items attached to this report have been reviewed and/or approved for form, legality and fiscal implications.

COST SUMMARY/IMPLICATIONS

If the City fails to place a lien to recover the delinquent taxes, the General Purpose Fund (1010) may potentially lose estimated revenue totaling \$57,793 for this period.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic</u>: Collections of delinquent real property transfer taxes have major economic implications for the City's sustainability. The revenue source is relied upon to fund essential City services.

<u>Environmental</u>: There are no environmental opportunities resulting from the recordation of liens.

<u>Social Equity:</u> Collections of delinquent real property transfer taxes have significant social equity implications for the City's sustainability. The revenue source is relied upon to fund essential City services to all citizens and taxpayers.


