RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF \$13,600 FROM COUNCILMEMBER SCHAAF'S GRAFFITI ABATEMENT MURAL AND GREEN WALL FUNDS TO CORUM LLC FOR TWO MURALS ON THE WALLS OF KING'S COFFEE SHOP AT 3000 38th AVENUE, OAKLAND

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2013, the City Council adopted a budget that set aside Graffiti abatement funds for Murals and Green Walls in the amount of \$50,000 for each council member to address graffiti within their districts; and

WHEREAS, the two walls on King's Coffee Shop are currently in a state of graffiti blight; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Schaaf wishes to grant a portion of her Graffiti Mural and Green Wall Funds to Corum, LLC for two murals on the walls of King's Coffee Shop to beautify this culturally rich neighborhood, as well as to abate and deter graffiti; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with City requirements Corum, LLC will provide documentation for the use of the Councilmember's Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall funds and for use of the proposed mural site; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the use of \$13,600 from Councilmember Libby Schaaf's Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall funds for a grant to Corum, LLC for two murals on the wall of King's Coffee Shop at 3000 38th avenue in Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to execute a grant agreement with Corum, LLC in the amount of \$13,600 for the above purpose, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
