RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution awarding a construction contract to Pacific Trenchless, Inc., the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, in accordance with plans and specifications for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Easement off Clarendon Crescent Avenue and Sunny Hills Road (Project No. C329135) and with contractor's bid in the amount of Four Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Eighty-One Dollars (\$445,081 00)

OUTCOME

Approval of this resolution will authorize the City Administrator to execute a construction contract with Pacific Trenchless, Inc. in the amount of \$445,081.00. The work to be completed under this project is part of the City's annual Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation program and is required under the 2014 sewer Consent Decree The work is located in Council District 7 as shown in *Attachment A*

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

On December 11, 2014, the City Clerk received four bids for this project in the amount of \$445,081 00, \$485,080 00, \$524,380 00, and \$547,700 00 Pacific Trenchless, Inc. is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and therefore is recommended for the award. The Engineer's estimate for the work is \$542,740 00. The proposed work consists, in general, of replacing approximately 3,439 linear feet of existing 8" diameter sewer pipes with High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) pipe, rehabilitating sewer structures, reconnecting house connection sewers, rehabilitating house connections sewers, and other related work as indicated on the plans and specifications This project is part of the City's annual Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation program intended to improve the sanitary system conditions throughout Oakland, and is required

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under the 2014 sewer Consent Decree Staff has reviewed the submitted bid by Pacific Trenchless for the work and has determined that it reflects the current construction market conditions

ANALYSIS

Adoption of this resolution will allow the City Administrator or designee to execute a construction contract with Pacific Trenchless, Inc., for The Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Easement off Clarendon (Project No. C329135). Under the proposed contract with Pacific Trenchless, Inc., the Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) participation will be 95.06%, which exceeds the City's 50% LBE/SLBE requirement. Trucking participation is 100% and exceeds the 50% requirement. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by Contracts and Compliance of the City Administrator's Office, and is shown in *Attachment C*

Construction is scheduled to begin in April 2015 and should be completed by June 2015. The contract specifies \$1,000.00 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract is not completed within 50 working days. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment B*.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) mandates the reduction of sanitary sewer flows during storm events. This project is part of the City-wide program to improve pipe conditions and reduce wet weather peak flows in sanitary sewer system.

PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

The Home Owner Associations, Merchants Associations, and residents in the easements areas have been notified in writing about this project. During construction, notifications will be sent to residents and businesses in advance of construction with information regarding planned construction activities, timeline, and contact information

Approval of this resolution will authorize the City Administrator or designee to execute a construction contract in the amount of \$445,081.00. This project will rehabilitate existing sewer pipes, reduce rain-related sewer overflows, and improve sewer pipe conditions in the area, and reduce ongoing maintenance costs.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

The Contractor Performance Evaluation for Pacific Trenchless, Inc. from a previously completed project is satisfactory and is included as *Attachment D*.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The contractors are all verified for Local Business Enterprise and Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) participation by the Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing. The contractors are required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents, which will result in dollars being spent locally.

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Environmental: The AMIP/SSMP will improve the overall condition of the City's sanitary sewer collection system and minimize sewer overflows, thus preventing potential harm to property, ground and surface water resources.

Social Equity: The AMIP/SSMP is a citywide program and will benefit the entire Oakland community and residents. It will ensure that Oakland has a reliable sanitary sewer collection system for years to come

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


