## **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the following Resolution with a new attestation date:

A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator To Submit A Foreign Trade Zone Alternative Site Framework Application And To Sign And Enter Into An Agreement With The Foreign Trade Zone Board Of The U.S. Department Of Commerce

## **OUTCOME**

Amending the attestation date on the resolution will allow staff to submit the updated resolution, together with an application to the United States Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ) Board to convert the Oakland FTZ #56 to the new Alternative Site Framework (ASF) program, to the Foreign Trade Zone Board by late April, 2015. The expansion of FTZ #56 through a conversion to the new program will attract additional manufacturing and goods movement, warehouse and distribution activities, and thereby increase employment in Oakland.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The City Council passed Resolution No. 85136 C.M.S. (Attachment A) on July 29, 2014. In August 2014, staff was informed by the Budget Office that prior to further expenditures from the Foreign Trade Zone revenue accounts, including the issuance of a purchase order for consulting assistance for the Alternative Site Framework application, appropriation actions with an accompanying resolution needed to be taken before City Council. This appropriation, Resolution No. 85364 C.M.S., occurred on January 20, 2015. (Attachment B). The Foreign Trade Zone Board has informed staff that the resolution authorizing the Alternative Site Framework application, now needs to have a current date. Staff plans to submit the Alternative Site Framework application by April 24, 2015, and request that the City Council update the resolution with no change to its substance.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO APPROPRIATE REVENUES GENERATED BY THE OPERATION OF THE OAKLAND FOREIGN TRADE ZONE #56 TO THE FOREIGN TRADE ZONE PROGRAM FOR PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT, MARKETING AND ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, The City of Oakland (the "City"), is a municipal corporation organized under its charter and the laws of the State of California, and

WHEREAS, in 1981, the City entered into agreements with the Oakland International Trade Center to operate the Oakland Foreign Trade Zone #56 ("FTZ") to stimulate economic activity through international trade, assembly, processing and manufacturing, and local jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Foreign Trade Zone designation allows companies operating within a federally-licensed Foreign Trade Zone to delay, reduce, and/or eliminate U.S. customs duties on imported merchahdise, raw materials and/or components, and thereby allows manufacturing companies to be more competitive in the global economy, to retain jobs and production domestically; and

WHEREAS, the federal U.S. Department of Commerce Foreign Trade Zone Board regulations mandate that all revenues earned by the City as the FTZ Grantee from licensee fees and administrative charges be used by the FTZ Grantee to support the operation of the Foreign Trade Zone, including administrative charges, marketing, education and technical assistance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the Interim City Administrator to appropriate the revenues earned by the City as the FTZ Grantee into various funds to operate the FTZ; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that the City Council hereby authorizes the Interim City Administrator to appropriate all revenues earned by the City from the operation of the Oakland Foreign Trade Zone #56 into the following Funds for FTZ Program operations:

General Purpose Org (1010), Economic Development Org (85411), Foreign Trade Project (P389610), Business Creation, Attraction, Retention, and Expansion Program (SC11) - Various Revenue and Expenditure Accounts (4XXXX and 5XXX); and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form and legality all revenue-generating license agreements of the Oakland Foreign Trade Zone #56, and all such agreements shall be filed with the City Clerk.


