RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH HINDERLITER, DE LLAMAS AND ASSOCIATES (HDL) COREN & CONE FOR PROPERTY TAX CONSULTING SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT (I) NOT TO EXCEED \$24,000 ANNUALLY FOR PROPERTY TAX ECONOMIC ANALYSIS, WEB BASED DATA AND STAFF TRAINING; AND (II) ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION NOT TO EXCEED 25% OF NET REVENUE DISCOVERED AND RECOVERED FOR THE CITY AS A RESULT OF PROPERTY TAX AUDITS PERFORMED BY THE CONSULTANT; AND AUTHORIZING THIS CONTRACT FOR AN INITIAL THREE-YEAR TERM WITH TWO OPTIONAL ANNUAL EXTENSIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland seeks to increase its revenue by securing payment of all taxes owed to the City; and

WHEREAS, in order to best achieve such an increase in revenue, the Revenue Management Bureau has determined that a contract with a tax auditing firm would provide the City with valuable information and services; and

WHEREAS, the Revenue Management Bureau issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for tax auditing and data services; and

WHEREAS, based upon a review and evaluation of the responses to the RFP, staff recommends entering into a contract with HdL, Coren & Cone (HdL); and

WHEREAS, the data and training to be obtained through the contract with HdL will be used by the Revenue Management Bureau for tax auditing, revenue forecasts, and trend analysis; and

WHEREAS, the City has been under contract with HdL for property tax consulting and auditing services since 1998 and has realized additional revenue as a result of services provided by HdL; and

**WHEREAS**, funding is available in the Revenue Management Bureau Annual Operating Budget, General Purpose Fund, account (1010.08451.54111.IP59); and

WHEREAS, the Revenue Management Bureau has reviewed the services and determined that this firm continues to provide the best and most cost-effective services; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That based on information provided by the City Administrator, the Council finds that this contract is of a professional and temporary nature and shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive civil service; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** that the City Council of the City of Oakland authorizes the City Administrator to execute a professional service contract with HdL, Coren & Cone for an initial three-year term, with two one-year options to renew, for property tax consulting services in an amount (I) not to exceed \$24,000 annually for property tax economic analysis, web based data and staff training, and (II) additional compensation not to exceed 25% of net revenue discovered and recovered for the City as a result of a property tax audit performed by the consultant; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality prior to execution and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
