REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

At the Public Works Committee on May 12, 2015, Committee members asked for clarification of time limits in the proposed RPP expansion in areas "D" and "DD" shown on the map attachment.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Area "DD" is a subset of Area "D"; the distinction was only drawn to differentiate an area within Area "D" where RPP permits will be paid for by Safeway as opposed to residents under normal conditions. Safeway is paying for Area "DD" permits to mitigate the parking impacts resulting from their College Avenue Store expansion. Area "DD" was created jointly by Safeway and residents. The Council resolution adopting the expansion of Area "D" does not distinguish or mention Area "DD" as it was strictly created for administrative purposes.

RPP is petition driven. Each block has its own petition, and each petition offers a choice between a two-hour or a four-hour time limit for that block (these time limits apply only to vehicles without a permit, i.e., a vehicle displaying a permit can be parked longer than the signed time limit). Upon Council's adoption of a resolution, staff will install parking signs indicating the tow or four-hour time limit as selected on the RPP petition for that block.

All of the blocks in the Area "DD" expansion will have a two-hour limit. Four out of the six blocks in the Area "D" expansion (Colby from 60th to McAuley, Colby from McAuley to Forest, McAuley from Howell to Ayala, and McAuley from Ayala to Colby) will have a four-hour limit. The other two blocks in the Area "D" expansion (60th from Claremont to Colby and Colby from 60th to 61st) will have a two-hour limit. These limits are the based on the block residents' choices indicated on the RPP petitions.
