RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt:

The Resolution Accepting and Confirming Reports of the City Administrator on the Costs Incurred by the City of Oakland for Delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes and Confirming the Recordation of Liens, Administrative Charges and Assessment Charges as Necessary Pursuant to Chapter 4.24 of the Oakland Municipal Code, and Directing the Notice of Lien and Assessment Charges to be Turned Over to the County Tax Collector for Collection.

OUTCOME

The lien will be recorded against one parcel. The parcel's delinquency represents \$839,443.56 in past due Transient Occupancy Taxes. Failure to place liens to recover the delinquent transient occupancy taxes will result in a loss of \$839,493.56 in revenues to the General Purpose Fund. The additional revenue of \$50.00 is derived from the \$50 administrative fee per lien for one property.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Pursuant to Chapter 4.24 of the Oakland Municipal Code, the hotel owner/operator was sent notices during a review and assessment process to address delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes determined to be owed to the City. An administrative hearing for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes was held on May 5, 2015 to hear protests and to resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by the hotel owner/operator regarding the non-payment of Transient Occupancy Taxes. The owner/operator was given the opportunity to appeal his/her case in this administrative process.

Following the administrative hearing, the Tax Administrator filed with the City Administrator a written notice of the person(s) on whom the City will file a lien for unpaid taxes, penalties, interest and other charges. If this amount remains unpaid or unresolved after the public hearing

by the City Council, the City Council shall authorize by resolution the recordation of lien on the subject property for costs incurred for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes and added administrative and assessment charge. The delinquent charge and assessment shall constitute a special assessment against said property, and shall be collected at such time as is established by the County Assessor for inclusion in the next property tax assessment.

The public hearing is scheduled for June 16, 2015. A resolution is prepared confirming the placement of a lien on one property and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges.

ANALYSIS

The hotel owner/operator owes delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes and administrative fees to the City for the account not resolved at the May 5, 2015 administrative hearing as shown in the *Attachment 1*. Hotel owners/operators collect the Transient Occupancy Tax from transients on behalf of the City, and it is their fiduciary responsibility to remit said taxes to the Tax Administrator by the due date as determined by their reported annual business tax gross receipts. If the City fails to place a lien to recover the delinquent taxes, the General Purpose Fund may potentially lose estimated revenues totaling \$839,443.56 and an administrative fee totaling \$50.00, creating a grand total of \$839,493.56 for this period.

PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

An administrative hearing for delinquent Transient Occupancy Taxes was held on May 5, 2015 to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by property owners regarding the non-payment of Transient Occupancy Taxes.

COORDINATION

In coordination with the Office of the City Attorney and the Controller's Bureau, the agenda report, resolutions and supporting items attached to this report have been reviewed and/or approved for form and legality.

COST SUMMARY/IMPLICATIONS

If the City fails to place liens to recover the delinquent taxes, the General Purpose Fund (1010) may potentially lose a total of \$839,493.56 for this period.
