President Gibson McElhaney and Members of the City Council:

Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled claim for the sum of Thirty-Two Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents Dollars (\$32,425.96), payable to James Williams.

This action arises out of a dispute between James Williams, a former Deputy Fire Chief, and the City of Oakland after he voluntarily resigned from employment in March 2013. Mr. Williams sought to cash-out his accrued sick leave hours. It was unclear whether Mr. Williams was entitled to cash-out his accrued sick leave at the time of his departure because he was an unrepresented employee but had received benefits similar to both Local 21 (allowing a cash-out) and Local 55 (disallowing a cash-out) while working as a Deputy Fire Chief.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, [date] (moved by Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan and seconded by Councilmember Noel Gallo – 7 Ayes, 1 Absent – Councilmember Larry Reid).

**WHEREAS,** Petitioner James Williams voluntarily resigned from the City in 2013 and sought to cash-out his remaining accrued sick leave but was denied; and

WHEREAS, On July 25, 2014, Petitioner James Williams filed a petition for writ of mandate and complaint for damages seeking the monetary value of one-third of his accrued sick leave hours; and

**WHEREAS**, without admitting fault or wrongdoing, the City has determined to compromise and settle Petitioner James Williams' claim against it for the sum of Thirty-Two Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents Dollars (\$32,425.96); now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of <u>James Williams v. City of Oakland</u>, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG14734547, City Attorney's File No. X04044, for a sum not to exceed Thirty-Two Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents Dollars (\$32,425.96) payable by the City of Oakland; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the sum of Thirty-Two Thousand, Four Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents Dollars (\$32,425.96) be made payable to James Williams.
