Pursuant to Section 401 of the City Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled action. Due to the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances settlement is recommended in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$20,000.00) payable to Plaintiff Laura Becerra and her attorney Thomas G. Lewellyn.

This action arises from an incident on January 22, 2014, wherein Ms. Becerra tripped and fell in on a metal hinge to a private elevator door opening located in the sidewalk adjacent to 1441 Franklin Street in Oakland. Ms. Becerra suffered injuries requiring medical treatment.

The City Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, July 21, 2015 (moved by Councilmember Gallo and seconded by Councilmember Kaplan - 6 Ayes, 2 Absent – Brooks and Campbell-Washington).
