- 7. Camps In Common in the Amount of \$40,000

OUTCOME

BACKGROUND

The FY 2015-17 Adopted budget is inclusive of grant awards for the above mentioned non-profits. However, the Resolution adopting the annual two year budget does not specifically address these non-profits in their entirety.

ANALYSIS

The grant awards are intended to support community programs and services benefiting residents of Oakland and youth attending Feather River Camp.

PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

There was no public outreach as a result of this staff report.

COORDINATION

Coordination and support for the grant awards was between Oakland Parks and Recreation (OPR), the Office of the City Attorney, Contract Compliance, and the City's Controller's Office.

COST SUMMARY/IMPLICATIONS

Funding for the non-profit grant awards is included in the FY 2015-17 two-year appropriation and from the General Purpose Fund. The following non-profits receive grants for each year, Fiscal Year 2015-16 and Fiscal Year 2016-17:

- East Bay Zoological Society In The Amount Of \$364,429,
- Chabot Space And Science Center In The Amount Of \$273,105,
- Friends Of Peralta Hacienda Historical Park In The Amount Of \$45,900,
- Oakland Asian Cultural Center In The Amount Of \$51,000;
- Oakland Children's Fairyland Inc. In The Amount Of 136,500

The following non-profits will receive funding in Fiscal Year 2015-16 only and are intended to support community programs and services benefiting residents of Oakland and youth who attend Feather River Camp:

- Oakland Parks and Recreation Foundation in the amount of \$50,000
- Camps In Common in the Amount of \$40,000
