NOTICE AND DIGEST AN ORDINANCE AMENDING OAKLAND MUNICI-PAL CODE CHAPTER 15.34 ("CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS WASTE REDUCTION AND RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS") TO ESTAB-LISH A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AGREE-MENT SYSTEM FOR THE HAULING OF SUCH DEBRIS TO BECOME EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE SUCH NON-EXCLUSIVE FRAN-CHISE AGREEMENTS

The Ordinance amends the Oakland Municipal Code to create a non-exclusive franchise sys-tem for the hauling of construction and demo-lition debris, authorizes the City Administrator to execute such agreements, and makes ap-propriate findings required by the California Environmental Quality Act.
