From: Information Technology Department Recommendation: Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator Or Designee To Execute A Master Lease Agreement(S) With IBM Credit LLC For Financing Not To Exceed An Amount Of \$17,000,000, A Term Of 7 Years And An Interest Rate Of 3.5% Tax Exempt And/Or 5.5% Taxable; And Waiving Competitive Selection Requirements For The Financing Agreement(S). Proceeds Of The Financing To Fund: (A) Current Information Technology Systems Operations And Maintenance: And (B) Project To Upgrade/Implement The Oracle Systems Including Hardware, Software, Professional Services, Support And Maintenance; And (C) Project To Implement A New Municipal Budgeting System Including Hardware, Software, Professional Services, Support And Maintenance; And (D)Project To Replace And Improve 9-1-1 Public Safety Systems Including Hardware, Software, Professional Services, Support And Maintenance; And 2.
