

RESOLUTION NO. 85852 C.M.S.

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER BROOKS AND VICE MAYOR KAPLAN

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF OAKLAND'S FISCAL YEAR 2015-2017 BIENNIAL BUDGET, WHICH WAS ADOPTED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 85672 C.M.S. ON JUNE 30, 2015

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 85672 C.M.S. on June 30, 2015, adopting the FY 2014-16 biennial budget; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland is facing a housing crisis, including displacement and lack of available affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, many tenants in the City of Oakland are being pushed out of their homes, sometimes in ways that violate the law, but there are not adequate resources to enforce tenants' rights, and more community outreach and education is needed; and

WHEREAS, the passing of Measure FF, pursuant to Resolution No. 85300 C.M.S., amended the Oakland Municipal Code establishing a local minimum wage and requiring employers to provide paid sick leave in the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, community education and enforcement of the minimum wage law is integral to upholding the integrity of the voter-approved ballot initiative, Measure FF; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 85672 C.M.S. on June 30, 2015 adopting the FY 2015-17 biennial budget, and appropriating certain funds to provide for the expenditures proposed by the said budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City's FY 2015-17 budget, which was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 85672 C.M.S., is hereby amended to adjust and allocate a <u>total of \$340,000 \$1 million</u> to the general fund to be used towards vital community needs as <u>detailed in "Exhibit A"</u>; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That of the \$340,000, \$240,000 will go toward the community based enforcement of minimum wage and paid-sick days law, and \$100,000 will be utilized for outreach and education of the Tenant Protection Ordinance and Just Cause eviction laws; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council of the City of Oakland hereby authorizes the City Administrator to amend the budget; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council of the City of Oakland hereby directs the City Administrator to implement the appropriations of the \$340,000 and to appropriate such funds respectively as described above. 1-million funds as presented in "Exhibit A".
