RESOLUTION TO RENAME THE GOLDEN GATE RECREATION CENTER THE CHARLES PORTER GOLDEN GATE RECREATION CENTER

WHEREAS, the policy to name a public facility is set forth in Resolution 65024 C.M.S., and requires that all requests for naming or renaming parks and recreation facilities be referred to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission (PRAC) and the Rules & Legislation Committee before the name is recommended to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Parks and Recreation staff received numerous requests from local community members to rename the recreation center after Charles Porter; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2015 PRAC unanimously recommended the renaming of the Golden Gate Recreation Center to the Charles Porter Golden Gate Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 65024 C.M.S. states that "facilities named for a specific individual should rarely be renamed, although the City Council could be flexible in renaming facilities originally named for geographical areas"; and

WHEREAS, Charles Porter was a long time Oakland resident and local community activist, who passed away on January 12, 2013, leaving a lasting legacy of his sincere dedication to Oakland and the Golden Gate community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Porter was a faithful member of the Neighborhood Crime Prevention Council Beat 10x (North Oakland Community) that met once a month at Golden Gate Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, Charles Porter also served as a member of the Golden Gate Recreation Center advisory board where he advocated for programs and activities that would meet the needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Porter worked diligently with the Golden Gate Recreation Center advisory board, staff, and the community in efforts to build a new facility with a gymnasium, a request of the local youth which Mr. Porter took to heart; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Porter sat on the project committee that was interviewed by the State of California Grant Office Officials in order to select a site to allocate funds, and Mr. Porter appeared voluntarily before the Oakland City Council to speak on behalf of the Golden Gate Recreation Center to receive funding for a new facility with emphasis on a gymnasium for youth; and

WHEREAS, in January 2016, after years of teamwork and struggle, the new Golden Gate Recreation Center will reopen, featuring a gymnasium for local youth and families, just like Mr. Porter championed for so long; and

WHEREAS, renaming Golden Gate Recreation Center after a long time local resident and community activist will provide a sense of honor for residents and support the lessons of community and civic engagement in local youth; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: The "Golden Gate Recreation Center" is hereby renamed and will from henceforth be known as the "Charles Porter Golden Gate Recreation Center".
