RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE UPDATED FY 2015-17 PARK PROJECT PRIORITIZATION LIST FOR CITY OF OAKLAND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR PROJECTS ON THE PRIORITIZATION LIST WITHOUT FURTHER COUNCIL ACTION

WHEREAS, in December 2007, City Council approved the FY 2007-09 Park Project Prioritization list and directed staff to return to Council on a two-year cycle concurrent with the budget to update the Park Project Prioritization list; and

WHEREAS, the Open Space, Conservation, and Recreation (OSCAR) Element of the Oakland General Plan serves as the official policy document addressing the management of open land, natural resources, recreation services, and parks in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the Park Project Prioritization List is developed per criteria of the OSCAR and serves as the guiding plan for implementing parks and open space capital improvement program and allows the City of Oakland to effectively respond to grant and other funding opportunities for park projects; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City of Oakland Council approve the Park Project Prioritization List attached hereto as **Attachment A** – FY2015-2017 Park Capital Improvement Project List; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Park Project Prioritization List continues to be reviewed and updated every two (2) years in conjunction with the budget process; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator or designee is authorized to apply for, accept and appropriate grant funds for the approved park projects as funding opportunities become available; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator or designee is authorized to enter into an agreement, execute, amend and other administration for awarded grants received for projects on the Park Project Prioritization List as necessary; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator or designee is authorized to re-order the projects within a Council District upon conference among staff and confirmation with the respective Council Office to allow flexibility to address changes in priority within a district;
