RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS FOR **ON-CALL** HAZARDOUS MATERIALS **CONSULTING SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO-**HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) EACH, FOR A THREE-YEAR PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 2016 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2019. WITH THE FIRMS: (1)ACC **ENVIRONMENTAL** CONSULTANTS, (2) NINYO & MOORE, (3) SCA ENVIRONMENTAL, INC., AND (4) SENSIBLE ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS, INC..

WHEREAS, the City desires to comply with federal, State and local environmental laws at properties that the City owns, operates, plans to acquire or intends to dispose of; and

WHEREAS, compliance with federal, State and local environmental laws is a critical component of park and facility renovations, sewer replacements and rehabilitations, streetscaping projects, maintenance operations, and development projects; and

WHEREAS, in order to achieve compliance, the City requires the assistance of environmental professionals to conduct asbestos, lead paint and mold analyses, write abatement specifications, monitor air quality, and perform other services related to the protection of human health and environmental resources; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to be able to respond quickly to deadlines associated with environmental laws and regulatory mandates, and such responsiveness is most effectively provided through on-call contracts; and

WHEREAS, the currently authorized contracts for on-call consulting relating to hazardous materials consulting services in support of all City departments and the former Oakland Redevelopment Agency will expire on June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, through the City's competitive Request for Qualifications process in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code section 2.04.051 for on-call hazardous materials consulting services, the four firms named in the title were identified as the top-ranked most responsive and qualified consultant teams to provide the desired professional services described herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the agreements authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the agreements directly or indirectly supports the City Council goal to "Develop a Sustainable City"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the agreements shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator or his/her designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into a professional services agreements for on-call hazardous materials consulting services with (1) ACC ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTANTS, (2) NINYO & MOORE, (3) SCA ENVIRONMENTAL, INC., AND (4) SENSIBLE ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS, INC; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the work shall be assigned on an as-needed basis and the total amount of each contract shall not exceed two-hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for a three-year period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator or his/her designee is hereby authorized and empowered to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreements with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of additional funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney and filed with the City Clerk's Office; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Agreements shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney and copies shall be kept on file with the City Clerk.
